

Coming to Your Bible

A recent article in *Christianity Today* is headlined: "Pop Francis: Why Everyone Loves the Pope." It lauds Francis' "unscripted" style "committed to breaking down the often-bitter rivalry between evangelicals and Catholics." Philippine Public Schools Wide Open to

Gospel Tracts

Reports are coming in from many foreign fields how gospel tracts are used to saturate communities resulting in new congregations, strengthened churches and fired up people. While it is getting more difficult to get tracts into some countries of the world, the Philippines remains wide open.

As of this writing, a 300,000-tract shipment to the Philippines is being boxed. The shipment will be divided up among dozens of local churches to saturate their communities with the Gospel.





No Sowing—No Harvest

Jesus used the parable of the sower to show the various ways the word of God is received. Sowing the seed was necessary before anything would grow, whether withered plants from shallow ground or healthy fruit from good ground.

Sowing was essential to any kind of harvest. So it is with gospel tracts: no sowing, no reaping. In the parable, much of the seed went to waste, but it still was worth the effort of doing the sowing to get a harvest from the good ground.

Some in the modern church have scorned soul winners who use tracts and street signs for appearing to relish it when sinners go to hell. We must be very careful of this attitude. True, Jesus was very pointed in His discussions with the scribes and Pharisees because of their hypocrisy and corrupt leadership. But, when he turned to the crowds following him, He groaned with compassion for them, who were lost without true spiritual shepherds.

When we pass a tract, if it is to a "Christian," it should be a challenge to a purer walk with Christ. If it is to an unbeliever, they come in two kinds: stony ground where the seed will not prosper and good ground where the Holy Spirit can nurture the seed into fruitful commitment to Christ.

If someone chooses to tear up the tract and put it in the trash, someday he may complain to Jesus on judgment day: "But... I didn't know!" And Christ will remind him of the gospel tract that went into the trash. At that point, he can only hang his head without excuse.

If the unbeliever's heart is touched, and he responds to the gospel, then the seed has fallen on good ground. Although we who plant tracts do not often see the fruit,



the thousands of testimonies that have come to Chick Publications show that there are eternal results. Two

young man stood on a cliff overlooking a wild river, determined to jump to his death. However, a flash of color in the dust at his feet caught his eye. He picked it up and discovered it was a Chick tract. The message forever changed his plans and several years later he called the Chick office to relate his testimony and that he now is a pastor.

Another man confessed that he had stolen a copy of *Holy Joe* from his attorney's waiting room but did not read it right away. As a flight instructor, he later read the tract while waiting for his plane to be serviced to take his last flight. But the message changed his plan which was to take the plane to an adequate altitude, nose it over and plant it, full speed into the middle of the runway. Instead, he submitted his shattered life to Jesus, went back and paid the attorney for the tract and led a fellow instructor to the Lord with it.

So, when someone tells you that tracts don't work, remind them that the Great Commission requires that the gospel be spread to everyone: believers, scornful unbelievers and responsive unbelievers. The Holy Spirit can then nurture the planted gospel depending on the softness of the hearts. We have seen letters from people who tore up the first dozen tracts they got, but one day, their heart was softened enough that the message could take root and they responded in faith.

But seed left in the warehouse cannot take root anywhere. Granted, some will be lost but there is always some good ground out there. However, without the seed, no life will grow. Proverbs talks about the farmer who gets no harvest because he was too lazy to work his field.

Will we "plant" enough gospel to get any harvest of Christ's approval on judgment day? Remember, three tracts "planted" every day equals a thousand a year. And everybody who reads one makes a choice —with eternal consequences.



Only 13 Percent of Next Generation are Bible Believers

Recent surveys of the next generation are shocking some church leaders. Evangelical authors Thom and Jess Rainer, in their book, *Millennials*, polled a cross section of the 18 to 30-year-olds and found only 13 percent of the 75 million alive today, were Bible believers. That fits the "narrow way" concept of Matt 7 and a smaller percentage than that "turned the world upside down" in the book of Acts. But it takes a sold-out, no-looking-back commitment that is rare in today's churches.

Lance Ford, in his new book, *Revangelical*, quotes a statistic that only 3 percent of non-Christian millennials hold a favorable view of evangelicals. He blames the perceived image of evangelicals in the culture of being "harsh, judgmental, compassionless and homophobic."

Ford places much of the blame on Christians who have played politics instead of putting faith first in their lives and reflecting the love and grace of Christ. While this is true, we have also failed to counter the intense campaign by the humanist schools and godless government to shove Bible believers into the margins of life.

Russell Moore, head of the Southern Baptist Ethics & Religious Liberty Commission, made a point in his acceptance speech for the position. He observed that the American culture is now in a post-Christian position and that Bible believ-

ers should shift to a "prophetic" stance. Instead of assuming that America is basically "Christian," we need a more realistic view of the lost condition of most people and do more to stand and speak God's Truth (in love) to their ignorance, indifference or even hostility. Jesus

in establishing polluted Greek and Hebrew texts as the foundational translation documents for not only English bibles, but all languages, both common and those used by organizations such as Wycliffe.

His book also describes how the Jesuits were central in this effort. Their goal is to get the Apocrypha included in your Bible to support more of their pagan doctrines. We are very late in this process. The present Jesuit pope is even now pushing hard for unity toward the end-times one-world religion.

SBC Conference Addresses Ministry to 'Gays'

So, how should we be thinking about witnessing to homosexuals? One pastor told of a young "gay" man brought to him during an outreach. "I can't help it, I was born this way," he said. The pastor replied: "Yes, I was, too. We are all born as sinners. I lived out my sin in drugs and alcohol before God saved me from my sin. God can do the same for your sin." Using that line of reasoning, he led the young man to trust Jesus.

The Southern Baptist Convention's Commission on Ethics and Religious Liberty recently hosted a conference on The Gospel, Homosexuality, and the Future of Marriage to bring together leaders and authors who have contributed to the dialog over homosexuality. Featured were special speakers, panel discussions, and opportunities of one-on-one dialog, even with same-sex advocates. Prominent were several who had exited the homosexual life style with the help of the Holy Spirit.

Central to the discussion was God's view of the subject as presented in the Bible. Perspectives that emerged included the fact that the subject in the Bible is bigger than just homosexuality; it has to include God's purpose for sex in general. Ex-homosexual speakers repeatedly described how their journey involved a careful reading of the Bible and a realization that nowhere did God appear to bless same-sex unions, even supposedly "monogamous" ones. It was obvious that His plan intended sex only in the context of a husband-and-wife relationship.

Another perspective of the ex-gays was that they discovered that they did not need to see their sexuality as their identity. They came to see themselves as a child of God first, and their sexuality only as part of God's overall creation of them as a person. Then the question became: how to please God with His gift of sexuality? The obvious answer from scripture did not include same-sex relationships.

The pastor's story of identifying with the sinner provides a humble approach to witnessing to a homosexual. Their sin is no different than anyone else who disregards or rebels against God's best plan. In the

limited to any election period, but began many decades ago when godless humanists were allowed into our schools, colleges and even some churches. Righteousness —Key to All Freedoms

No freedom is so precious as the freedom of speech. If Satan can shut that down, then all other freedoms are squelched. Much of the world's political regimes have no tolerance for such an awesome freedom. But the so-called Western World has stood firm for several centuries protecting this freedom.

However, new forces are beginning to erode the wall. Examples include the arrest last year of Peter LaBarbera and Bill Whatcott at the University of Regina in Canada. Their offence was simply holding up signs and passing out flyers presenting God's opinion about abortion and homosexuality. They were arrested in April and charged with "mischief." Free speech became the central issue in the subsequent trials which have yet to be concluded. When university officials asked them to leave, they refused on free speech grounds.

Whatcott is a Canadian citizen and has stood firm in his bold public stand against abortion and sodomy.

LaBarbera is a U.S. citizen

who is president of Americans

For Truth about Homosexuality (AFTAH), one of the most prominent organizations standing for traditional marriage.

In late October, LaBarbera returned to Canada to stand trial with Whatcott on the mischief charge. Upon arrival, he was detained by customs agents who thoroughly searched his phone, laptop and papers in his luggage looking for evidence of violation of Canada's "incitement to hate" laws. They confiscated a DVD produced in Russia called "Sodom" on that premise. Testimony during the trials centered around free speech questions.

Canada's constitutional guarantees for freedom of speech are not as solid as in the U.S., however, but the attacks are from two directions: homosexual rights and Muslim

ship of the wafer-god and virgin goddess, works salvation, and the pope's claim that tradition and the Magisterium are equal to

or supersede Scripture.

Even after all these changes, we would have to ask, which Bible? Author David W. Daniels points out in his book, Why They Changed the Bible, how all modern Bibles are increasingly slanted to support Rome's pagan dogmas. An entire section is devoted to the scheme to include the Apocrypha in the Bible. He describes how the Bible societies were, from the



local public schools. In mid October, they put tracts into the hands of thousands of students at five local elementary schools. As a result, many more of the students are attending Saturday Bible studies and youth fellowships. Church members stepped up and helped in organizing the flow of the tracts to the schools. Tracts were also supplied to other, smaller schools, outside the local area.

"God has answered our (you and us) prayers for helpers in the ministry. They signify willingness to help us. In fact, this November, a group of young people are assigned to help us distribute tracts to 5 high schools in time for the youth camp this coming April 2015," writes Carey.

The Careys are beginning to anchor

other tract ministries in neighboring towns and schools. Other missionaries and pastors are becoming interested in duplicating the Carey's methods of tract saturation outreaches to their communities and local schools.

One country in turmoil is China. One missionary has succeeded in developing a network of contacts who are willing to risk their lives to get Bibles and tracts

to the university students in Beijing. He writes that there are now more Christians in China than communist party members. This has the government nervous and they have declared there will be more freedom of worship, but it seems only a trick to get the underground churches to come out in the open more. When they do, but refuse to register with the government, they are shut

down and leaders imprisoned. Meanwhile, God is allowing this missionary to get dozens of boxes of tracts and precious bibles into the cities where persecution is greatest. Much of the outlying areas are heavily Christian with less government pressure. Wherever he can get the tracts in, they are effective in reaching the lost and edifying the saints.

pressure. The incident above is the result of legislation granting homosexuals the same legal rights that religion, race and ethnicity enjoy. Homosexual activists are demanding that any speech that disagrees with

their agenda be outlawed as "hate speech." Canada has bought this reasoning and the arrests mentioned above show the result.

Muslims, on the other hand, are using their "blasphemy" laws in their Qur'an-based Sharia legal system to convict anyone who "disrespects" Allah or Muhammad.

The world first became generally aware of this when Salmon Rushdie published

a book called "The Satanic Verses." Muslim leaders took offence and put out a call to kill Rushdie. At the time that seemed laughable until Dutch filmmaker Theo

van Gogh was assassinated for a movie deemed critical of Islam and Muslims rioted in Europe and the Middle East over the publishing of some cartoon characterizations of Muhammad by a Danish newspaper. Rushdie spent years in hiding and the Western World suddenly realized that the threats were no laughing matter.

The advance against this essential freedom has emerged because of the Western World's forsaking righteousness. We are destroying God's plan for solid, stable families by legalizing the sin of homosexuality and abortion, and idolizing evil musicians

and corrupt entertainers.

In the past, immigrants who came for the economic opportunities were sure to be exposed to the gospel or at least to a culture that honored

biblical principles. During that time, Muslims were discouraged by their leaders from coming to the U.S. because they risked exposure to a loving God who wanted them free from their bondage to Allah. Now, the church is so weak and the culture so pagan,



final analysis we all have the same choice: Will we do it God's way or our way?

When you get right down to God's way, the

Bible presumes that there is some sort of a choice involving our sexual feelings as well as our actions. We are to "set" our "affections" on things above (Colossians 3:2).

We agree that it is best not to "set our affections" on someone else's spouse when we already have one of our own. God does not make any difference when it comes to same-sex affection/attraction. The instructions in Proverbs 4:23 to "keep (guard) your heart..." also appears to apply here. If we let our hearts wander into porn on the internet, we are not exercising the "diligence" commanded here.

When King David neglected his duty to lead the army, and stayed behind to ogle Bathsheba from his roof top, he did not guard his heart and he, and many others, paid dearly for it. When a teacher suggests to a student that same sex attraction can be okay and should be cultivated, this is a huge violation of the biblical directive on handling our affections.

Witnessing to the homosexual has been a problem for many Bible believers. But the cross provides forgiveness for ALL sin. The main conclusion from the SBC conference was that we should strive to

help all sinners, "gays" included, to strive for holiness first, a life committed



to pleasing God, then

all sins are dealt with by the Holy Spirit's ongoing work of sanctification.

words to the level of man's.

The Vatican desperately needs the Apocrypha in the Bible. When they cannot distort a Bible passage to fit one of their pagan doctrines, they resort to the Apocrypha. For example, their teaching of purgatory is based



on the Apocryphal books of 2 Maccabees 12:45 and Tobit 12:9. Using money to pay for sins appears in Ecclesiasticus 3:30 "Water will quench a flaming fire; and alms maketh an atonement for sins."

The Apocrypha also contains such strange advice as using smoked fish liver to dispel demons (Tobit 6), and suggest that suicide, in some cases, is manly and noble (2 Maccabees 14:37-46). Strange historical inaccuracies also appear, such as the death records of Antiochus Epiphanes, who must have died twice when you compare 2 Maccabees 2:13-16 to 9:1-29. A search of Christianbook.com turns up 46 items for sale related to the Deuterocanonicals/Apocrypha, with over two dozen Bibles that include them. Supposedly these are only for Roman Catholics, but Daniels' research discovered that the groundwork has been laid over the decades within the Bible Societies to ultimately produce

a Bible with the Apocrypha and subtle watering-down to create one world Bible for one world religion. This Jesuit pope's PR campaign continues to sugarcoat the bait in the trap for Evangelicals who have already swallowed the poison of the modern (Catholic) versions.
