Like America, Israel came through a series of miracles to arrive in the promised land. Their prosperity peaked during the reign of Solomon but morally and spiritually it was downhill from there. Moses cautioned them in his last memoirs against the danger of prosperity. He predicted that their hearts would turn away from the God Who had so miraculously blessed them.


Of course they believe that the easiest

The pandemic also showcased the Pope's dedication to ecumenism. He has already come out as a proponent of an interreligious day of prayer. In 2019 he visited the United Arab Emirates where he cosigned with Sheikh Ahmed el-Tayeb. prosperity, the leaders of surrounding nations came to see the blessing that God had poured out upon his people. They understood that it was because of obedience to God that they were so blessed.

America's prosperity has also been a great blessing to the Kingdom of God. Using a powerful Bible, revivals turned many, many hearts to righteousness. That same prosperity funded a worldwide missionary outreach that went a long ways to fulfilling the scripture that the gospel would be preached to all nations. (See Matt. 24:14.)

However, like Israel, a few generations of that prosperity have led to massive idolatry in America. The idolized sexual pleasure of the sexual revolution that began about 75 years ago led to the legalization of a number of sins: abortion, approval of sodomy and same-sex marriage.

Other idols include materialism (he who dies with the most toys wins); evolution (God is dead, and it is up to us to save the planet); celebrity worship in both entertainment and sports, etc.

After Solomon, the Kingdom of Israel was divided into two major sections. One got almost immediately into idolatry. The other section maintained a semblance of worship for a few generations longer. But eventually God did what He promised: if they profaned His land with innocent blood and failed to maintain personal righteousness in humility before Him as Creator, they would be evicted from His land to be scattered among the nations.

We have no way of knowing whether America will follow Israel's pattern in this regard. Under some rulers Israel would turn away from their idolatry for a while. Perhaps if we will challenge our churches to repentance, God will grant us a reprieve from the pattern of Israel's judgment.

Nation's First High School LGBTQ+ Course In Maryland

Two high schools in Maryland are scheduling a pilot course on the "history and culture" of homosexuality. The Montgomery County Board of Education **unanimously approved** the development of the curriculum to be offered in the spring semester.

Activistmommie.com reports that Scott Murphy, director of secondary curriculum told the board members that there was a strong interest in the course. "During initial implementation, we would gather feedback and then come back to you about the success of the pilot to either open it up to all schools or to continue to revise the pilot course," he said.

Board member Patricia O'Neill expressed pride in the community's "commitment to equality."

Several things are terribly wrong with this picture.

• First of all, if this is to be an unbiased "history" course, **will it include** some of the earliest history when God expressed His opinion about homosexual behavior at Sodom and Gomorrah?

- Will it include the pain and suffering by participants in this abnormal lifestyle from the high degree of sexually transmitted diseases (STDs)?
- Will it showcase the testimonies of the confusion and suffering of children who grow up in the shadow of two-dad or two-mommy "families?"
- Will it include the testimonies of the thousands who have been through the pain and mental agony of following that lifestyle and escaped from it by the power of the gospel?
- Will it include the sordid history of the lives of the leaders of the Roman Empire and the Apostle Paul's opinion about such behavior in Romans 1?
- Will it mention that the suicide rate among homosexuals is many times that of the general population?
- Will it illustrate the mismatch of the anatomy and the consequences of misuse of that anatomy?
- Will it give a balanced view of the propaganda fostered by Hollywood that the "gay" lifestyle is enjoyed by beautiful people in contrast to the truth of the high violence, promiscuity and homicides of that lifestyle?
- Will it draw a parallel between the decay of previous cultures and the wholesale adoption of sin?
- Will it draw a parallel between child molestation and a propensity to homosexuality as an adult?
- Will it include any mention of the fruits of the "sexual revolution" as it has destroyed families, diverted young men's attention away from the responsibilities of family life, and young women away from their natural nurturing of the next generation?

Another thing that is so horribly wrong with this picture is the absence of any of the school board members or public comments raising objections to this plan. Where were the Bible believers when these board members were elected? And where were they when this pivotal meeting convened?

The comment about the "commitment to equality" speaks worlds how skewed our moral sense has become. What other sins will we eventually consider "equal?"

Is it not enough that we have spilled 2 million gallons of innocent blood since legalizing the sin of abortion? **Is it not enough** that we now have over 50 different STDs more widely spread since legalizing sodomy? **Is it not enough** that we now have grown men in track meets outracing girls and then insisting they use the girl's bathrooms and showers?

The debate will be endless whether the coronavirus was God's judgment, but who can deny that we have strayed far from His prescription for a healthy culture?

When the school official gets around to "gathering feedback," Christian parents ought to be front and center there. We deplore the devilish drift of the government schools, but electing school boards and lobbying for righteousness in the schools is a place in our own neighborhoods where our voices can be heard.

And don't forget, another way to promote righteousness in your neighborhood is broad distribution of gospel tracts.

World Missions Changing

CBN News reports that a major shift in world missions is occurring with the new generation. During the last century the primary focus of missionary activity was from West to East and South. Now, increasingly, that is reversing.

Gospel seeds planted in the past have flourished into mature churches. These are now sending out missionaries to new mission fields as well as back to challenge the apostacy growing in the western world.

"So, from countries that used to be the focus point of mission, they have become the major players in mission," says Dr. Corne Bekker, dean of Regent University's school of divinity.

The U.S. is still the country sending the most missionaries, but more than half of the total worldwide come from South America, Asia, and Africa. "People are basically going from everywhere to everywhere," says Baylor University missionary expert Dr. Robert Woodberry.

One classic example is Mongolia. Tennessee-based Mission Eurasia is working with believers in Russia to send

Why Young Christian Leaders Are Losing Their Faith By David W. Daniels

He wasn't the first to lose his faith in God. And he certainly won't be the last. Here's why.

Jon Steingard grew up in a loving Christian home. His world was church. He did as other Christians did: accepted Jesus into his heart, prayed and participated in ministry. He gravitated toward worship teams, and at 20 years old, joined a Christian band, Hawk Nelson, in 2004.

Many things about Christian culture made him uncomfortable. But what really got to him were the Bible questions he had and contradictions he found. He needed answers.

While discussing a Bible concern, his fatherin-law thought the problem was from the King James. He said he felt that King James had "put his own spin" on issues, so "that version couldn't fully be trusted," advising Jon to "go back to the original Greek."

Jon said "...you believe that modern translations can't fully be trusted, because they are human, flawed, and imperfect? I am simply taking that thought to its next natural conclusion —that the original Greek is also human, flawed, and imperfect, and also can't fully be trusted."

His father-in-law said, "Well, if you believe that, what do you have left?"

"Exactly," Jon replied.

Listen to Jon's words. "Once I found that I didn't believe the Bible was the perfect Word of God it didn't take long to realize that I was no longer sure he was there at all.... The implications of that idea were absolutely massive."

It took a year of Jon working through depression before he made this public announcement. But what happened next should shock you.

Jon wrote, "I have had private conversations with trusted friends about my doubts, and discovered to my absolute shock that *they are shared by nearly every close friend my age who also grew up in the church.* I am stunned by *the number of people in visible positions* within Christian circles that feel the same way as I do."

Jon was not the first. And he will not be the last. For years, I've said that this would happen. We are giving trusting young believers contradictory Bibles and justifying them. This leads them down the road of confusion, doubt, disbelief, and rebellion, often resulting in rejection of God or disbelieving in Him entirely.

Pastor, you were mentored by men who were grounded in the KJV, or their mentors were KJV men. Your faith is solid. But what will happen to *the next generation?*

In Deuteronomy 6:6-7 God said through Moses, "And these words ... thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children..." We have no excuse. We must learn the scriptures and pass on our faith to the next generation. In Nehemiah 8, people born in Babylon came to Jerusalem. Ezra read to them in Hebrew, and helpers "gave the sense" so they could understand the words. They didn't change the words.

The coronavirus pandemic has created huge challenges for missionaries all over the world. As governments try to limit contact with people, it has been necessary to find new ways to get the gospel into the hands of millions who have no hope, only fear.

One of the most popular methods being used is the preparation of food packets for

those trapped in their homes, unable to work to feed their families. In Ghana, missionary Abel Veennema uses the tracts you provided as he speaks in schools, and goes door to door with the gospel. During Ghana's pandemic lockdown, they made 700 food parcels to help families in need. As you can see in the photo, a Chick tract went into each one. 
God gave no mandate to "dumb down" the Bible. Instead we were to *raise up* godly offspring schooled in His words.

dozens of Russian teams to Mongolia holding camps for thousands of children. Many have never heard of Jesus. Mongolia statistics tell the story: At the time of the fall of the Soviet Union, there were only 10 believers in the entire country. Twenty-six years later, there are 60 thousand spread across the vast area.

Mission Eurasia leaders believe that the future of the former Soviet countries, as well as Russia, is more in the hands of the next generation of Christians than the political leaders.

Pew Research estimated that the hunger for God in the entire sub-Saharan Africa is greater than any other place on the planet. Another estimate placed Iran as the country with the fastest-growing underground church. Brazil recently hosted several conventions attended by 140 thousand who pledged to dedicate their lives to the Great Commission. They were joined by three million more online making the same pledge.

More evidence of the progress of the gospel is the increased persecution in India and China. Hindus perceive a threat to their power and are beginning to attack congregations and pastors. Believers in the underground Chinese churches are said to number between 60 and 100 million. The communist government is beginning an open crackdown, jailing leaders and bulldozing buildings.

Intriguing stories are slipping out of the Muslim world of quiet believers who risk their lives if they are known to have left Islam. Many undercover

notice that much of the suffering has been in areas where we have gotten farthest away from God.

These are sobering times, soul winners. The message of the Old Testament prophets was not very well received. But "missionaries" are the foreign workers from the Philippines and other Asian nations, hired as domestics and teachers to the wealthy Muslims.

The danger is so high that even rough estimates are hard to come by. With Satan's barrier against the gospel so tight, we even have stories of Jesus, Himself, invading the land. Some with an honest and hungry heart have had the Lord appear in their bedroom.

Israel, almost inadvertently, has had a positive effect here. It is a small island of prosperity and freedom in the vast sea of Islam's spiritual oppression. With the broad permeation of the social media technology, the common people are becoming more aware of their lack of freedom. Many political leaders are attempting to crack down against the threat to their power. They are finding that brutality is no match for Biblical love.

Chick Publications has been pleased to share a small part in this missionary effort. Millions of tracts have flowed into the Philippines, India, and even China before the recent clamp-down. Throughout history gospel tracts have had a significant part in revival and missionary efforts.

Several years ago, tract users in this country kept asking how they could supply tracts to missionaries. We set up a small fund for donations and it has grown to supply large numbers to missionaries who found that they greatly extended their outreach.




