New Law May Forbid Soul Winning in Russia

A new restriction on religious activity, supposedly to curtail terrorism, has Russian Bible believers deeply concerned. On July 3, President Putin signed a law that, when enforced, will require prior authorization from the state for even sharing the gospel during a conversation.

Barnabasfund.org reports that: "Even in a private home, worship and prayer will only be allowed if there are no unbelievers present." Violation of this would draw a \$770 fine, and if the person belongs to an organization such as a church, it could also be fined \$15,500.

When is Witnessing Allowed in Public Schools?

Christian public school students are increasingly facing opposition to witnessing and practicing of their faith. A recent brochure by the Christian Educators Assn, Intl (CEAI). lays out guidelines for parents and students showing exactly where they stand in a possible dispute with school officials.

First of all, everyone needs to understand First Amendment rights. CEAI points out: "The Supreme Court has repeatedly held that the First Amendment requires public school officials to be neutral in their treatment of religion, showing neither favoritism toward or hostility against religious expression such as prayer."

The framers of the constitution wanted to make sure there was a level playing field for private individuals to exercise and promote their faith, free of any government interference

As it appeared that the man would surely die, the pastor's wife called the family to see if she might be more accepted by the man. They agreed to try. She relates what happened:



Anti-Jewish Persecution Rising in U.S.

A steep rise in anti-Semitism is occurring in America, with a significant portion in U.S. colleges. "We are disturbed that violent anti-Semitic incidents are rising," observed Jonathan Greenblatt, chief executive of the Anti-Defamation League.

Divestment and Sanctions (BDS) movement. Wikipedia describes it as a "global campaign attempting to increase economic and political pressure on Israel to comply with the stated goals of the movement: the end of Israel's occupation and colonization of Palestinian land."

Assaults Up 50 Percent



ADL reports that the number of actual assaults on Jews in the U.S. in 2015 was up more than 50 percent over the year before. It tracked 941 incidents of harassments, threats, and vandalism. 56 of those were actual, physical assaults. They believe that there may have been more not reported by the victims.

One international group with chapters in many universities is called the Boycott,

Hate Crimes: Jews 56% —vs. Muslims 16%

The FBI weighed in with a report that 56 percent of the anti-religious hate crimes in the U.S. in 2014 were "motivated by anti-Jewish bias." This compared with only 16 percent targeting Muslims. Results of this indoctrination

in the universities are showing up in the younger leaders in government and business. Relations between the Israeli government and the current White House have become increasingly strained.

Only in the last 75 years has America demonstrated serious anti-Jewish efforts. During America's founding, George Washington received major help from



LGBT Activists Now Targeting Christians

New items collected just for this issue of Battle Cry exceed two dozen on the threat of the LGBT assault on Christians. In California, a new LGBT curriculum for public schools has been approved by Education Department officials. Second graders will now learn about families with two moms or two dads. Fourth graders will learn about Harvey Milk, a "pioneering gay politician" in San Francisco who romanced teen boys and ended up murdered in his office. Other LGBT people and milestones in history will be laced into lessons all the way up the grades.

Elsewhere in California, Christian colleges are watching a couple of bills in committee. Both deal with "discrimination" by the

or promotion. Therefore, any time a teacher or school official, acting in official capacity, attempts to promote (or discredit) a religious viewpoint, they are no longer "neutral."

On the other hand, when they are speaking as "private individuals," they are free to practice and promote their religions, just like students and parents are.

So, in every situation, the main question is whether the person is acting as government official or as a private individual. When a teacher orders a student not to bring a Bible to class, she is no longer neutral. The student is acting as a private individual and is protected under the Constitution. However, if the student is reading the Bible during class time when she ought to be paying attention to the lesson, the teacher would be right to direct the student to put away the Bible and concentrate on the lesson.

"Freedom of expression" is another constitutional right as private individuals. This includes both speech and written expression. Students, or teachers, do not shed this right "at the schoolhouse gate." Distribution of literature is considered "pure speech," according to

schools toward LGBTQ applicants. One stipulates that, if the school accepts students who receive Cal Grants, a state scholarship, it must certify that it will not "discriminate" on the basis of sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression. This prevents the school from holding up any biblical standard if they accept students who receive this state aid.

The other bill also pressures Christian schools that hold a Federal exemption from anti-discrimination laws, which prevents them from being forced to hire homosexuals and accept non-believers as students. The proposed bill demands posting of signs on campus explaining their "discriminatory" policies. This invites lawsuits by anyone

the courts, thus covered by the freedom of speech clause of the Constitution. However, schools can protect class time by stopping any disruption caused by either kind of speech. But during recess, lunch or other free time, the student cannot be stopped from freedom of verbal or written "expression."

"Students not only have the right to verbal and written speech, they have the right to persuade, advocate and even proselytize a religious viewpoint," according to the CEAI brochure. The courts have recognized that this can foster a controversy and even start an argument. But this freedom of expression is worth the risk and in many ways the source of our independence and vigor as a society. The opposite is oppressive dominance by a totalitarian government.

The courts have also dealt with the question of prior notification. Some colleges and cities have tried to require a permit for witnessing. This is contrary to the constitutional freedom of speech. The courts have held that "spontaneous speech" is fully covered in freedom of speech. Therefore, neither can free, spontaneous speech be confined to a limited area, such as

Jewish merchants. Gratitude for that remained until the early 20th century.

"offended" by these policies.

In Southern California, Robert O. Lopez, a Bible-believing professor at Cal State University in Northridge forfeited his tenure and his job rather than sacrifice his belief in God's plan for marriage. After being forced to resign, he writes: "I had served for eight years under a dean trained in Women's Studies. surrounded in her executive suite by lesbians and feminists, who hated me for celebrating the beauty and glory of chastity and Biblical love. I could not have my relationship with Jesus Christ and this job simultaneously. The choice was not that difficult." After years of hacked computers, vandalized office, and false complaints against him, Lopez gave it up for Jesus Christ.

It seems that Christian parents hoping to protect their kids' innocence have nowhere to hide them. Even "Nickelodeon 'makes history' with its first 'gay married' couple in kids cartoon," the headline reads. Viewers discover that Lincoln Loud in *The Loud House* has a friend with two dads.

Of course, it is not all new because Nickelodeon had already "introduced" a bisexual couple in *The Legend of Korra* in 2014. Similar episodes have recently showed up on the Disney Channel's *Good Luck Charlie*, and the Cartoon Network in *Clarence*.

Churches in Iowa are having to fight a

new interpretation of Iowa's civil rights act. An amendment was added prohibiting "discrimination" in "public accommodations" because of a person's sex, sexual orientation or gender identity.

Since churches "accommodate the public," a strict interpretation of the law would force churches to hire practicing homosexuals. It could even open them to lawsuits if a transgender person was offended by biblical preaching or was prevented from using the bathroom of their choice.

Many Christian businesses have also been attacked for their stand against same-sex marriage. Christian bakers and florists have lost their businesses in lawsuits for refusing to participate in same-sex weddings. ChristianMingle and eHarmony were both forced to include same-sex ads in their dating service.

Throughout history, Satan has used government to attack believers. We really need to counterattack. America's founding fathers built barriers around our freedom to witness that are crumbling. But our weapons are not carnal. We must vote for leaders who will best protect our freedom, but unless true revival takes root, we will only have bad people to vote for.

"The family said yes since he was so sick and probably wouldn't be mean to me. But when I got there —I watched him die. It was the most awful and frightening thing I had ever seen. He sat up in the bed with his eyes wide open and mouth gaping. His arms flung in the air and he said, 'Help me!' The machines then began to buzz, nurses came, and his family was screaming together, 'He went to hell! Oh, God, he went to hell.' The nurses promptly gave them all a sedative. The nurses closed the man's eyes and put his hands down to a normal position. As long as I live I will never forget that death."

Someone has reasoned that modern medicine has changed this so that we rarely see this today. Most people die in hospitals where they are carefully monitored and given sedatives in the last hours, dulling the senses and "allowing a peaceful death."

But this may be denying us strong evidence of the reality of the hereafter. One Chick Publications staff member, who grew up in Mexico, said that dying with extreme horror, or bliss if they are believers, is common where she lived.

One research file obtained on the internet listed hundreds of deathbed stories, posted at http://www.cuttingedge.org/shaw/. The book is old but the experiences are timeless and descriptions highly detailed. Some are even of famous "infidels." Other accounts are of famous believers who displayed great joy at being welcomed by angels or deceased

family members.

Part of our witness as believers is to remind people of the long view. Life does not stop at the grave, as evolutionists and humanists would have us believe. Satan's answer to these death-bed experiences is hallucinations of the expiring mind, but man cannot escape the spirit within that whispers otherwise.

And when we hand someone a gospel tract that speaks to that vacuum in the soul, some will respond to Christ's gift. Unfortunately, we have no way of knowing who will respond and who will reject the message. That's the reason Jesus used the parable of the sower to show the need to spread the gospel seed widely.

Over the centuries, gospel tracts have played a major part in preparing people for revival. Never has there been a more desperate need for revival, than now. More and more missionaries are discovering that if they saturate a community with Chick tracts, they often get sufficient response to start a congregation. We were so excited! My wife Deborah and I were going to hear my Bible college Greek professor preach on the Resurrection at a local church. He said Mark 16 would be his only text. I was sure of what he would say. But I was so wrong.

Instead, this text critic told us about some "very significant omissions" in "the oldest manuscript," Codex Sinaiticus. He claimed that, originally, Mark 16 only had 8 verses. He guessed that the last 12 verses were added later, because someone simply misunderstood the abrupt ending to the Gospel.

In verse 8, the King James and most Bibles say the women left the tomb afraid —which seems a strange way to end the

By the way, when I was a teenager, it was Chick tracts that put the fear of God in my heart."



Gospel. But he claimed "afraid" could also mean "in awe." So the women left the tomb "in awe" —end of story. He wouldn't read verses 9-20, because, they weren't in the "oldest and best" Greek Codices (big books) Sinaiticus or Vaticanus. So Jesus never appeared to anyone, nor even rose from the dead, according to this "text critic's" gospel of Mark.

My wife Deborah and I left that church on Resurrection Day —with no bodily resurrection!

Our professor taught, like most text critics, that Mark was the first Gospel written. But all history shows the order as Matthew, Mark, Luke, John. Then text critics say that Mark was written by someone else, after Mark died. So none of the Gospels or New Testament books were written by eyewitnesses. But the books themselves say they are (Acts 4:20; 2 Cor. 15:4-8; 2 Peter 1:16-18; 1 John 1:1-4).

If you trust text critics, the original gospel had no bodily resurrection! That's because their favorite two manuscripts out of 620—Sinaiticus and Vaticanus— are missing the last 12 verses of Mark. But why trust them? Are they really "oldest and best"? Few text critics have even seen more than a page or two. They just trusted their professors—and doubted the consistent witness of history.

But things are changing. Now we can see high-quality photos of Vaticanus and Sinaiticus online. And we can ask the simple questions people should have asked over 150 years ago. Why would critics disregard the evidence of 5,700 other manuscripts? What made these two so good and reliable?

Since December 2015 I have asked basic questions. They are revealing startling answers. You can see them yourself at youtube.com/c/chicktracts or chick. com/bible. Look for the playlist called "Something Funny About Sinaiticus."

History proves that Satan couldn't destroy the Bible. So he decided to use scholars who


claim they can "fix" the Bible. And they do it with manuscripts that have no history. They just magically appeared: Vaticanus in 1475; and Sinaiticus in 1844. Suddenly everyone was supposed to change the Bible to match them. And they don't even agree with each other in thousands of places!


To this day, no one has even done chemical tests to figure out the age and makeup of the parchment and ink of Sinaiticus. They've exposed other counterfeits that way. But they refuse to check Sinaiticus.

We already have a trustworthy Bible. The Hebrew Old Testament was passed down through the tribe of Levi, carefully copied. Later synagogues followed those practices. Then from the 500s to 1000 AD, the Masoretes continued carefully copying. The Masoretic Old Testament Text is reliable.



Churches are limited in contact with foreigners. Non-Russian citizens would be required to have a work visa to attend a church service or be fined and expelled from the country.

Originally billed as anti-terrorism legislation, there appears to be no exemption for churches, except, possibly, the Russian Orthodox. Objections were raised before the bill passed and slight amendments were made. But critics claim these only tilted the favor toward the Orthodox to the exclusion of other groups. This drastically reverts the attitude of the government back to the severe oppression of the Stalinist regime.

Missionary activity in Russia has always been difficult because Russian identity and the Russian Orthodox church have been so intertwined. As with countries where Roman Catholicism dominates, the civil government is never free from the dictates of the "church."

Protestant leaders are hoping that, when it comes to enforcement, they will be cut some slack. But there will be a chilling effect on witnessing, nevertheless. This will provide enemies of the gospel with a weapon to use if they wish.

This is an extreme case of a drift away from religious freedom that is happening throughout Europe. Britain is debating a law to tackle Islamic radicalization and counter the terrorism threat. The center of the debate is about the definition of "extremism."



Wishing not to offend "moderate" Muslims, they are trying to make the law so

general that other groups that pose no threat are worried.

This illustrates a very basic quandary on the Western World. We have valued freedom so highly that we have thrown away reasonable constraints. The individual person has been given such freedom "rights" that even sins like abortion and same-sex marriage are accepted.

What is done in the bedroom by consenting adults is deemed to be no business of the government, and therefore society. The same goes for pregnancy. Government, society, or even parents, should have no say over what a woman does with her body, even if she is a minor.

Humanism has taught us this kind of "liberty" (license). But along comes a

religion, Islam, which has taken advantage of this freedom to promote world conquest with



death to anyone who opposes it. Suddenly anyone who pushes his belief on others is taking an "extreme" position and must be stopped.

This general law is proposed to give the government power to monitor any organization that may be fomenting some extreme position, such as jihad —or soul winning. If same sex marriage is the norm, then it is "extreme" to speak against it, even just by quoting God's opinion on it, the Bible.

It remains to be seen how far the rest of Europe, and even America, will follow Russia on this. Where the political power of the Russian Orthodox "Church" has drawn a severe line against soul winning, Europe's religion of humanism may also use this opportunity to squelch the gospel.

As we have seen in America, Islam, humanism, and the sodomites have made much progress using the levers of political power to eliminate God and the Bible from our schools and the public square.

Soul winners, we need to get busy while it is so safe and convenient. Clouds of persecution are gathering.


