

Column 1 contains verses from this reader's 1611 Bible. Column two contains the same verses from the 1599 Geneva Bible, and column three is from the 1611 King James Bible, in Roman Type, a word-for-word copy of the original 1611 printing.

Notice that the words in column one and two are the same (with only minor spelling changes). That's because these are both Geneva Bibles, one printed in 1599 and one printed in 1611. Column three, on the other hand, contains wordings that are different! This is the 1611 King James Bible.
