


Terrorism Must Be Answered With Revival

No Sowing —No Harvest

Jesus used the parable of the sower to show the various ways the word of God is received. Sowing the seed was necessary before anything would grow, whether withered plants from shallow ground or healthy fruit from good ground.

Sowing was essential to any kind of harvest. So it is with gospel tracts: no sowing, no reaping. In the parable, much of the seed went to waste, but it still was worth the effort of doing the sowing to get a harvest from the good ground.

Some in the modern church have scorned soul winners who use tracts and street signs for appearing to relish it when sinners go to hell. We must be very careful of this attitude. True, Jesus was very pointed in His discussions with the scribes and

Is the King James Bible All Wrong About Death and Hell?

Is it true? Is the King James Bible a goldmine for groups that don't believe in hell? After all that I have said about the new Bibles removing the word "hell" and some of the words about hell, I was amazed to find out a new accusation: That the King James is dangerous because of the times it doesn't translate the Hebrew Sheol or the Greek Hades as hell! And that the cultists just love to use the King James because of this supposed "mistake."

Well, the accusation is just wrong. Satan sure hates the King James Version. Is there no limit to the lies he will cook up about it?

They can't be talking about the New Testament. Hades only appears in the New Testament 11 times. And 10 times it is translated "hell." Just one time it is translated "grave:" 1 Corinthians 15:55: "O death, where is thy sting? O grave (hades), where is thy victory?"

Look at the context! This is talking about the afterlife, but it's not about torments of hell as we English-speakers understand it—which is always negative. The translators chose to use the word "grave," to describe being put in the ground, to descend into the afterlife, whether to paradise, "Abraham's bosom," or torments—what we call "hell."

1 Corinthians 15:55 is a direct reference to Hosea 13:14. "I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death: O death, I will be thy plagues; O grave, I will be thy destruction..." Grave, of course, is "Sheol" in the Old Testament because it was written in Hebrew.

Believe it or not, that was something the King James translators didn't have to fix. 36 years before King James, the Bishops Bible translated Hebrew "Sheol" and Greek "Hades" the same way, with the

same words. The Bishops Bible translators had already gotten that right!

"Okay," you say. "But what about the 31 verses in the Old Testament that Sheol was translated 'the grave'?"

Great question. Totally fair. So let's look at the very first time the King James translators ever translated Sheol as "the grave" instead of "hell." Genesis 37:35. "And all his sons and all his daughters rose up to comfort him; but he refused to be comforted; and he said, For I will go down into the grave unto my son mourning. Thus his father wept for him." The word for "grave" here is Sheol. Jacob didn't mean he was expecting hell—he's referring to death. Again, you've got to look at the context.

But why fault just the King James? There are 15 other versions, 5 of them Jewish, that translate Sheol as "the grave" in this verse including: The NIV (1984 and 2011), The New Living Translation (1996, 2004, 2007), The New King James (1982); 5 Jewish Bibles, including The Complete Jewish Bible (1998), Jewish Publication Society (JPS) 1917, and the Rabbi Isaac Leaser Bible (1853).


So you see, translating Sheol and Hades by two words, "hell" and "the grave," depending on the context, is nothing new. We have lots of words in English that have more than one meaning, depending upon how they're used.

Other Bible versions are the ones at fault when they minimize hell by leaving Sheol and Hades untranslated, with "hell" in the Bible only a few times, or as some do leave it out altogether!

Which would you rather have: A Bible that removes "hell" altogether, and refuses to translate the Hebrew Sheol and the Greek Hades? Or one that has a lot of "hell" in it? I want everyone to avoid hell at all costs. So I've made my choice. How about you?

What some have called the "clash of civilizations" is at the



Are Modern Bibles Built on a Faulty Foundation?

One of Satan's prime strategies is counterfeiting. For 200 years a billion-dollar industry has been built upon trust in two foundational documents.



In 1611 it was published and became simply, "The English Bible."

Trust in this Book inspired the greatest revival and missionary effort the world has ever seen.

However, God's sworn enemy had not been idle. About 200 years after its birth, a movement arose to "update" this Bible. Was it an honest effort to adapt to changes in the language? Or were nefarious forces determined to take down this lion of a book?

Regardless, this revision effort of 1870-1885 ignored thousands of manuscripts available—and settled on just two. These two became the foundation of all modern Bible versions, along with their Bible-doubling footnotes.


Now, along with other researchers, David W. Daniels is discovering the possibility that one of these two pillars supporting the modern, billion-dollar industry is a counterfeit, faked by Jesuits and other New World Order hacks.

Details are too complex for this writing, but there appears to be some dark historical mystery surrounding both the Codex Sinaiticus and the Codex Vaticanus. Daniels is viewing data recently posted on the internet to show suspicious alterations of Sinaiticus just before Westcott and Hort almost exclusively relied upon them to create their Greek New Testament, the foundation of all modern versions.



Daniels has posted a playlist of vlogs on YouTube detailing these findings. If evidence continues to verify this view, how many will have the courage to stand against this monstrous fakery?

As Daniels points out: "All this confusion is completely unnecessary for anyone who chooses to stand on the proven reliability of the words of God preserved in the Bible that King James authorized."

the argument that it is discriminatory to keep boys-turned-girls off the sports team of their chosen "identity." The unintended consequences came up when the "girl" that looked like a boy wanted to shower with the other girls that looked like girls.

School districts have taken various approaches trying to make accommodations, since the Feds have threatened to cut off Education Department funding if they don't.

Some put up special curtains but ran the risk of the "parents" complaining that this, too, amounted to a form of "discrimination" and risked offending the singled-out student.

Some school districts claim that the bathroom is not an issue, since individual stalls are available to assure privacy. Many parents are not comfortable with that "solution."

Like Houston, concerned parents and leaders see the ballot box as a suitable response. California is one of the states that has adopted policies forcing schools to allow transgender students to use locker rooms and bathrooms of their claimed "identity." Opponents are mounting a ballot initiative at present.

General anti-discrimination policies of eleven other states are being interpreted

as opening the bathrooms and showers to students based on their choice.

This "identity" appears on the surface to be purely objective on the part of the student. Some have pointed out that this fulfills the fantasy of any red blooded teen guy to get to undress in the girl's locker room.

Some administrations have put down stipulations that the student has to show a consistent pattern of "transgenderness," even requiring a note from a recognized therapist. This also goes against the LGBTXXX drive to "normalize" this behavior that "deviates" from the Creator's intention for marriage.

As the general public becomes outraged over this assault on the privacy of our children, soul winners must shoulder some of the blame. Had we been fully diligent with the Great Commission, perhaps this legalization of sin would have been prevented.

Recent Court Cases Approve Public Witnessing

A couple of obscure cases were decided in court recently providing precedents for soul winning protection in public places. One case involved a group of "Christian Evangelists" who confronted a Muslim festival in Dearborn, Michigan in 2012. Their approach involved abusive signs and a pig's head. Of course, the response quickly turned violent requiring police intervention. ([Searching "Dearborn" on the Chick.com website brings up other BATTLE CRY articles posted at the time.](#))

Instead of providing protection from the rioters, police escorted the Christians from the scene. They sued, and after several appeals, the full 6th Circuit Court of Appeals found in their favor and awarded them damages for violation of their First Amendment rights.

As described in a [July 2012 BATTLE CRY](#) article, soul winner Tim Berends infiltrated the same festival quietly wearing an "I ♥ Muslims" T-shirt, and offering everyone a Chick Tract. Moving gently

through the crowds of the three-day festival, he salted in 4,000 copies of the tract, *Unforgiven*, with no hassle. Media pictures show a smiling woman wearing a Muslim head scarf accepting a tract graciously offered by Tim.

The "wise as serpent, harmless as a dove" approach seems to work the best. Nevertheless, the court case won by the other group is important for all of us. It again illustrates the strength of the Constitution's guarantees of freedom of speech and religion in public places.

The other recent case involved church signs in the little town of Gilbert, Arizona. Pastor Clyde Reed was using small yard signs along a thoroughfare to direct people to his Sunday meetings. He placed them the night before and retrieved them after service the next day.

City fathers mandated that the signs not be up that long and threatened a fine.

There is only one solution: revival. King Solomon observed in Proverbs 14:34 that "Righteousness exalteth a nation: but sin is a reproach to any people." Many decades ago Lady Liberty began losing her hold on righteousness. Soon Supreme Court decisions began legalizing sin.

Only time will tell if the Western heart can be restored. But Bible believers are the only hope. No doubt these are the "perilous times" of 2 Timothy 3. Without another Great Awakening, only Christ's return wielding His "rod of iron" (Rev. 19:15) will be able to set things right again.

In the meantime, we soul winners are to "occupy" until He comes, whatever happens. Occupy does not mean sitting around waiting on our "blessed assurance." The question still hangs in the air: Will we be found faithful to the Great Commission?

Pharisees because of their hypocrisy and corrupt leadership. But, when he turned to the crowds following him, He groaned with compassion for them, who were lost without true spiritual shepherds.

When we pass out a tract, if it is to a "Christian," it should be a challenge to a purer walk with Christ. If it is to an unbeliever, they come in two kinds: stony ground where the seed will not prosper and good ground where the Holy Spirit can nurture the seed into fruitful commitment to Christ.

If someone chooses to tear up the tract and put it in the trash, someday he may complain to Jesus on judgment day: "But... I didn't know!" And Christ will remind him of the gospel tract that went into the trash. At that point, he can only hang his head without excuse.

If the unbeliever's heart is touched, and he responds to the gospel, then the seed has fallen on good ground. Although we who plant tracts do not often see the fruit, the thousands of testimonies that have come to Chick Publications show that there are eternal results. Two striking stories come to mind: One Chick tract "seed" was planted in a remote Alaskan wilderness. A distraught young man stood on a cliff overlooking a wild river, determined to jump to his death. However, a flash of color in the dust at his feet caught his eye. He picked it up and discovered it was a Chick tract. The message

forever changed his plans and several years later he called the Chick office to relate his testimony and that he now is a pastor.


Another man confessed that he had "stolen" a copy of *Holy Joe* from his attorney's waiting room but did

not read it right away. As a flight instructor, he later read the tract while waiting for his plane to be serviced to take his last flight. But the message changed his plan which was to take the plane to an adequate altitude, nose it over and plant it, full speed into the middle of the runway. Instead, he submitted his shattered life to Jesus, went back and paid the attorney for the tract and led a fellow instructor to the Lord with it.


So, when someone tells you that tracts don't work, remind them that the Great Commission requires that the gospel be spread to everyone: believers, scornful unbelievers and responsive unbelievers. The Holy Spirit can then nurture the planted gospel depending on the softness of the hearts. We have seen letters from people who tore up the first dozen tracts they got, but one day, their heart was softened enough that the message could take root and they responded in faith.

But seed left in the warehouse cannot take root anywhere. Granted, when sown, some will be lost but there is always some good ground out there. However, without the seed, no life will grow. Proverbs talks about the farmer who gets no harvest because he was too lazy to work his field.


Will we "plant" enough gospel to get any harvest of Christ's approval on judgment day? Remember, three tracts "planted" daily equals over a thousand a year. And everybody who reads one makes a choice—with eternal consequences.

Was he in your church Easter Sunday?


He heard the message, and knew he needed to get right with God. But not that day. He just wasn't ready.

Other political and commercial signs were allowed. Reed asked for legal help from Alliance Defending Freedom (ADF), who won the case, again on Constitutional grounds. Such cases don't make front page headlines, but are huge for soul winners. They set legal precedents that can be used in future cases where overly zealous offi-

cialists attempt to limit our right to witnessing in public places.

Many church leaders today are disparaging street evangelism, pointing to confrontive techniques used by some groups as discrediting the gospel. For some, the shock effect is necessary to divert them from hell. Others respond to the gentler approach. In any case, engaging gospel tracts extend the witness far beyond the event, carried home to quietly urge response when the heart becomes receptive.

An Open Mission Field Next Door

Today, we are told that there is a record number of inmates in America's jails and prisons. Statistics show that our incarceration rate of over 700 per 100,000 is the highest in the world.

One has to wonder if it is because of our diligent rule of law that convicts a greater number of perpetrators. The general corruption that goes unpunished in many countries would, no doubt, outpace the U.S. if everyone had to pay for their crimes.

Nevertheless, these sad statistics are a huge challenge to the church. Present prison ministries find many open hearts when they care enough to develop this fruitful mission field that is so easily accessible.

One of the most successful prison ministries for the last several decades is Mission Possible in Inverness, Florida. A story relayed by Chaplain Allan Woody is of a death row prisoner. He remembered the cloud of despair was thick in the cell row of prisoners waiting execution. As Chaplain Woody walked by each cell, he would be asked, "Are you coming to see me?" The despair in the voices tore at his heart but he had been cleared to only see a specific one.

Once in the cell with the inmate, he spent an hour discussing how to gain peace with God and hope for eternity. As he prepared to leave, assuring the inmate of his prayers as he awaited his day, the inmate replied, "Brother Woody, everybody is on death row. I just know my date."

The incident was early on in Chaplain Woody's ministry, but it settled in his spirit as a urgency to reach as many prisoners as possible. Over the years he placed hundreds

of thousands of tracts, bibles and other literature in any prison where he could. Chaplain Woody has passed on, but is now rejoicing in heaven with some of those whom he guided into the Kingdom. His wife is continuing the ministry. She writes: "Many do not realize they are on death row and only the Savior can grant a pardon through His shed blood on Calvary."

The huge prison population in the U.S. means that there is probably one (or more) of these mission fields near you. Churches who really want to make a difference in their community will not overlook this opportunity. The loneliness and boredom of the men (and women) makes them super receptive to gospel literature and personal witness. By now, most know in their hearts that they are sinners, so are already on the first step to salvation.

My little 12-year-old niece was visiting us and I told her about Lloyd. She wanted to see him. So on our next trip to see Lloyd, she joined us. When Lloyd saw her, he brightened up and thoroughly enjoyed her telling him about Jesus. She was beautiful, and a delight.

Fred and I went again, but Lloyd was too sick to see us. A day or so later he died. Both Fred and I felt like failures. But last night, Margaret told me that just before Lloyd died, he called out the name of Jesus, three times, and passed on. I got tears in my eyes!

I believe my little niece was used by God to save Lloyd's soul.


Old folks love to see and talk to young people. You may face the same problem someday. If you have a young person who loves Jesus, encourage them to witness to some old soul. It just might work.




