The official Catechism of the Catholic Church seems to come down on the side of the Biblical view of homosexual behavior. But the Pope's recent remarks appear otherwise.

According to the Catechism:

"...homosexual acts are intrinsically disordered," and the inclination to perform them is "objectively disordered."..."Under no circumstances can they be approved."

The Catechism, however, appears

Suicide —Looking for Help In All the Wrong Places

Leaders today are puzzling over a nearly 60% jump in suicides among young Americans since 2007. The ages range from 10 years old to 24. Some states experienced

a greater number than others, but the phenomenon was broad. Thirty-two states have had increases of 30 to 60 percent.

When searching for a cause, some authorities came up with an increase in gun sales and the economic recession. Of course, the coronavirus epidemic was high on the list. Others expressed confusion, saying the situation was complicated and not clearly understood.

Solutions included locking up the guns and drugs that were often the tools used in committing suicide, and calling the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline.

Every sign of unjust discrimination in their regard should be avoided."

This continues the pattern of Roman Catholicism's talking out of both sides of its mouth. Although its mantra is: "Rome never changes," history shows that it is very adept at adapting to the shifting winds of culture.

Even when Pope Francis was just a Cardinal in Latin America, he personally supported civil unions for homosexual couples. Now he continues to make statements in that direction.

Pope Francis responded to a reporter's question about homosexual priests in 2013: "Who am I to judge?" One homosexual sexual abuse survivor reported that the pope told him that God had made him gay. In a recent documentary video he appears to be endorsing civil unions for same-sex couples.

This is another case of someone who abandons the word of God and exposes their real motives. Ever since the establishment of the Roman hierarchy under Constantine, Rome has been at war with God's preserved words.



Ancient Fortress More Evidence of Bible History

While constructing new housing in the Golan Heights in northern Israel, workers unearthed what appears to be a fortress used by one of King David's allies. Israel Antiquities Authority believes that it belonged to the kingdom of Geshur.

Stone walls encircled a small hilltop, an ideal observation view. Numerous artifacts were used to identify the original owners of the fort, including an ancient ring and a figurine of a woman with a drum.

Other stone carvings were found, including one of a moon god. The site is being preserved for additional excavation. Numerous other Geshurite sites have been discovered in that area.


The Geshurites did not belong to the tribes of Israel, but cooperated with King David as an ally. One of David's wives, Maachah, was the daughter of a Geshurite king. Their son, Absalom, murdered his half-brother, Amnon and fled to Geshur.

ready to commit his or her life to Jesus, a reward for her effort.

But this story is only one of many, illustrating the battle that is being mounted against our freedom of religion.

The attacks are actually coming from several directions. Secular evolutionists have deeply embedded themselves in our government institutions and academic schools. They have paired up with the violent homosexual lobby in their hatred for the gospel.

An additional attack is coming from a third direction —Islam. French President Macron is currently dealing with this in his attempt to tamp down Islamic radicalism.

Each of these forces has its own agenda. Satan has convinced the atheistic humanist that there is no God and any suggestion otherwise has to be squelched. COVID-19 has certainly changed everything —including the door-todoor activity of the Jehovah's Witnesses. Beginning in March 2020, the Jehovah's Witnesses stopped their door-to-door activity, known as the "Field Ministry." Does that mean that they have ceased from their proselytizing? No.

Perhaps you have received a letter from one of the Jehovah's Witnesses with a pamphlet inviting you to view their website, jw.org, and to join one of their "Bible Studies." A letter-writing campaign is their new proselytizing strategy.

In light of today's events such as COVID-19, and civil and political unrest, the Watchtower is certainly not slowing down their campaign in reaching prospective converts. In fact, events like this is exactly what the Watchtower's Witnesses will use to proselytize —by using fear as a means to convert the unsuspecting. In sharp contrast, the Word of God does not use fear to intimidate people to serve God; the Word of God tells of God's love for man by giving us hope which is found in Jesus.

So what do you do if you get those letters? Read what they have to say and reply.

• Thank them for writing to you. Be

cordial and friendly. Wait for their response.

• When they reply, again, read what they have to say. They may talk about presentday events. Again, fear will be behind the scenes, and of course, the only hope of escape from this mess is to be one of Jehovah's Witnesses.

• Do not be hostile, or argumentative in your responses. I always tell people, "If you want to witness to Jehovah's Witnesses to make a point, or to win an argument, then you have no business speaking with the Witnesses. Witnessing to the Jehovah's Witness is about being patient.

• Get a copy of <u>Winning the Witnesses</u> to learn how the Witness thinks and comes to his conclusions. You need to have an understanding how the Witness thinks before you reply. The last thing you want is to put up a barrier between you and the Witness.

Above all, pray for the Witness you will be sharing the gospel with. Then, use wisdom in discussing issues with the Witnesses as found in <u>Winning the Witnesses</u>. Your job, if you will, is to plant seeds. The Lord will work behind the scenes in convincing their need for Jesus as you present the gospel in a non-confrontative and loving manner.

Sermon Gets Air Force Chaplain Discharged

In 2013 Air Force Chaplain Kurt Cizek preached a message on sexual immorality. Although homosexuality was mentioned in the sermon it was not the focus. "If you're having sex with somebody that you're not married to, then you need to stop," he recalls saying. He even pointed out that it was hypocritical to target homosexuality without equally giving God's opinion about heterosexual sin.

Of the 2,500 trainees that heard that sermon, only one person filed a complaint, a lesbian trainee. When the complaint reached an "openly lesbian commander, she wouldn't let it go."



Now performance reports began to be down graded and he was twice passed over for promotions. Finally, he was involuntarily "separated" from the Air Force in 2016.

So far, he has been unsuccessful in getting a hearing on appeal. He has contacted legislators and the White House, but was put off to review boards.

The Founding Fathers originally established the chaplaincy with the belief that spiritual morale was essential to the function of the military. They made it a paid position within the military ranking.

The discharge denied Cizek pension and health benefits upon retirement worth over a million dollars. But the bigger issue is the denial of basic First Amendment rights. If injustice such as this is allowed to stand, no one's freedom to practice his religion is safe.

We have granted rights to homosexuals to do what God calls "sin." Yet, they are never satisfied. Norway is an example: one of the most open societies to tolerate homosexual behavior. They allow full freedom to self-identify one's own gender. But now, word comes that they have amended their penal code to penalize even "private remarks." Those convicted of hate speech over the dinner table, face one year in jail for private remarks and a maximum of three years for public comments.

Many feel safe growing up under the protection of the US Constitution and assume that it will never be eroded. Supreme Court Justice Samuel Alito recently told a gathering of the Federalist Society that religious liberty is "in danger of becoming a second-class right."

He said that the coronavirus pandemic has "resulted in previously unimaginable restrictions on individual liberty." He cited the bias when churches in Nevada were ordered closed while casinos were allowed to operate at 50 percent capacity.

He also cited hostility toward religion in the academic world and in some large corporations. Anyone who states that marriage is a union between one man and one woman is accused of intolerance, homophobia and bigotry.


However there is some glimmer of hope. Since the latest appointments to the US Supreme Court, two decisions have been handed down in favor of churches that were being squeezed by state and local governments.

The New York governor's efforts to suppress church and religious worship were rebuked by the Supreme Court. A similar case involving California was returned to the lower court with instruction to reconsider based on the New York ruling.

While this war for the soul of America rages on, we need to redirect people's attention to the main issue. Our founding fathers said that this constitutional government would not work without

United Kingdom - Cross Mission

While lockdowns and fear of disease during the COVID-19 pandemic have made missionary work more difficult in many parts of the world, there are still missionaries who refuse to quit. They just find a way.

In the United Kingdom, Sean Lee with Cross Mission writes: "We are a mission organisation located in Wales. Wales used to be a country of revival and there are many who remember the most recent revival movement in Wales. Yet now very sadly, it is difficult to find faithful christians at the moment. Churches are filled with elderly members mostly who experienced and tasted the revival but their faith failed to reach the next generation, which reminded me of Judges 2:10: "there arose another generation after them, which knew not the LORD, nor yet the works which he had done for Israel."

"So every missionary in Cross Mission is trying to bring the gospel back to Wales and the UK (and all nations!) But due to the COVID-19 situation, it became hard to reach people so we decided to distribute the gospel tracts house to house. We are

planning to reach all the villages in Newport where we are located. (~150,000 people) We used to use conventional gospel tracts but thanks to the Mission Fund at Chick, we could distribute cartoon gospel tracts, which we feel that would be much friendlier for unbelievers. People need to stay at home mostly during this pandemic situation and we reckon that this is a good chance to reach them by gospel tracts!"

Thanks to your giving, we have been able to send 30,000 tracts to the U.K. for this outreach plus another 30,000 for a related outreach. As lockdowns there have tightened even further (at the time of this writing) we believe people will be all the more interested in reading the tracts delivered to their homes. 

Israel

Once again, we are preparing a large shipment of Chick tracts for Israel. And this time, there will be three different titles in the special dual-language editions, Hebrew and English. Reading a cartoon tract in two languages is a great tool to present Jesus to the many Jewish immigrants who are struggling to learn Hebrew —the language of their new home. If you haven't seen one of these, they look like this (Hebrew reads right to left):

Kenya - Open Air Campaigners

You continue to provide shipments



for their outdoors campaigns, with people coming for tracts and a movie about Jesus. "We gave out thousands of your tracts in the schools after assembly programs (they were given to the teachers to give out in the classrooms, or students would have been trampled). All the teachers wanted them, and thanked us for coming. There is total religious liberty to preach the gospel in the schools... the principal decided to give us the whole student body...all 2,900 of them... the largest number of students we have ever spoken to at one time. Almost none of the schools have auditoriums, so we meet outside. Assemblies are no problem with high school students, but elementary students can pose a problem if there are too many. They put us on a large raised circle of earth, but as we began, a teacher told the students to come in closer.

This immediately started a wave of children pushing forward and up over the circle as they charged us. Alarmed, I silently prayed to God for Him to protect the children from being trampled, and us from being pushed over. After beginning the message again, God answered and graciously came down upon them. They became quiet and still as He spoke to their hearts through His



word. Although we won't know until heaven how many truly trusted Christ as Savior, the sound of many voices praying to receive Him at the end of the message reminded me of His words: "Suffer little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven." Both Elaine and I put our trust in Christ when we were young. After thanking God for what He did, I decided that future assemblies will be limited to 1,500."

Their ministry is expanding into the Congo, so your gifts are providing them with a regular flow of French tracts for that area.



"I'm a truck driver."

"...with this thing (COVID) going around, everybody's taking the tracts! I can't believe it!

"Now, hardened old truck drivers that I know would never take the tract before, are saying 'Yeah, I'll take it.' Everybody knows something is up. So many people are taking them and reading them right there where they're standing.

"Three of my friends here in the valley have accepted the Lord. One just four weeks ago from reading those tracts. He came to my apartment and said, 'I accepted Jesus!' This was a truck driver that's a hardened guy. When he goes to jail it takes four policemen to arrest him, because he ain't going. That's the kind of guy he is, and he accepted Jesus."

virtue in the people. What they meant was, righteousness in the hearts of the citizens.

We need to find every possible way we can to "reprove" the sin that has been legalized in our culture. In the meantime we must "proclaim from the housetops" that righteousness can only come in a life committed to following Jesus.

Saturation with no-nonsense gospel tracts has played a significant part in past revivals. Revivals cannot come without wholesale repentance, which is a major theme in Chick tracts.

commented on the construction of her altar that, because of the restrictions on visitors to hospitals, people die alone, but the altar "...makes it even more important that we welcome them [their spirits] back." Another, explaining the significance of the incense said that it clears the space of any negative energy or bad spirits and helps the dead find their way.

The celebration has a very complex root system in the history of Catholicism. Ultimately it taps into the teaching of purgatory where departed Roman Catholics spend an unknown amount of time in torment paying for light-duty (venial) sins that were not absolved prior to death.

Heavy-duty (mortal) sins are a different matter. Unless they are fully "absolved" before death, chances of heaven are limited. Purgatory is not considered adequate for mortal sins. However, the pope has a fix for that, providing that a priest is handy before death. The predeath ceremony of Last Rites can smooth the pathway into eternity. But pinning down this process is difficult due to the convoluted nature of Catholic teachings. It basically involves confessing to the priest who has the power to forgive (absolve) it.

In *Night Journey from Rome*, ex-priest Clark Butterfield describes a continuous and pervasive sense of guilt that he experienced as a Roman Catholic: "It is the syndrome of constant, oppressive, unshakeable awareness of guilt, and it is simply and accurately labeled, 'Catholic guilt.' It is unique and peculiar to that system." Describing his decision to become a priest: "I simply reinserted myself into the intricate web of guilt, punishments, penances, ritualism, and on-again off-again salvation, a ready victim for the powerful assaults of the devil..."

"My guilt feelings began in those early grade-school years. I began to question the integrity of my Confessions —did I confess everything I had to? and the correct number of times? Was I truly sorry? Did I receive Communion in the state of grace, or was I condemning myself to hell by unworthy Communions? Did I pay proper attention at Mass? Did I consent to 'impure thoughts'? The list is endless. And the guilt accumulated and extended its venom to all my waking hours...

"Rightly did Martin Luther call the Catholic practice of obligatory confession to a priest 'a butchery of consciences," says Butterfield.
