Canada's Dangerous Slide into Euthanasia

Imagine living in a society where your life is considered unworthy of care simply because of a disability, chronic illness, or mental health struggle. In Canada, this troubling reality is becoming increasingly common as the country accelerates its embrace of euthanasia at the highest levels.

Canada is Killing its Citizens

It all began in 2016 with a law allowing terminally ill patients to seek assisted death. Since then, the law has expanded to include individuals with disabilities, and by 2027, it will encompass those with mental health conditions—regardless of whether they are dying.

Quebec has become the epicenter of euthanasia, now leading the world in assisted deaths, with over 10,000 Canadians—more than 3% of all See Euthanasia page 6

Divine Consequences? The Ceasefire Deal and California Wildfires

John P. McTernan's book As America Has Done to Israel suggests a shocking link between U.S. foreign policy and natural disasters. When the U.S. pressures Israel to go against its interests, he argues, it could trigger divine retribution in the form of catastrophic events. With the devastating California wildfires in January 2025 and the recently brokered ceasefire between Israel and Hamas, we may be witnessing a frightening example of this theory in action.

A Bad Deal for Israel

On January 15, 2025, the U.S. brokered a ceasefire between Israel and

Palestinian factions. But the deal was a bad one for Israel. In exchange for halting military operations, Israel was forced into unfair concessions—and the terms heavily favored Hamas.

A thousand Palestinian prisoners—including 110 individuals serving life sentences for terrorism—are set to be released. These are people responsible for killing Israeli citizens, and now they'll walk free. In exchange, Israel will receive just 33 hostages. But here's the catch: there's no proof of life for many of the hostages. Israel is trading terrorists for hostages, and

Surgeon General's Farewell Prescription

When outgoing U.S. Surgeon General Vivek H. Murthy bade farewell, he offered a final prescription for healing a fractured society. His message, surprisingly aligned with biblical values, urges Americans to prioritize relationships, service, and purpose. In a world that often values wealth, fame, and individual achievement, Murthy's prescription provides a powerful antidote: true fulfillment in living for something greater than ourselves.

Relationships are the Heartbeat of Well-Being

Murthy's father grew up in rural India and experienced life in a true community. In a village without running water or electricity, the villagers thrived by supporting each other. They knew each other's stories and cared for one another like family. When Murthy's father lost his mother at a young age, it was his neighbors who stepped in, becoming surrogate parents. For him, that sense of community was indispensable.

Despite having fewer material goods in India, he never felt like he lacked because the sense of belonging was so strong. It wasn't until he left the village and moved to the west that he felt like something was missing.

Most Americans feel the opposite — isolated. Our culture of individualism leaves people longing for connection. Murthy argues that we need shared experiences and stronger bonds like his

thoughts, and trauma from sexual assault. In her fragile state, online transgender activists convinced her that her pain stemmed from being "born in the wrong body." She believed them and turned to medical professionals for help. Within months, she was prescribed testosterone and underwent a double mastectomy.

Now, at 26, Mosley looks back and calls these treatments out for what they are —"pseudoscience" and "quackery." She recognizes that her distress stemmed from untreated mental health struggles and a need for truth. But instead of receiving proper care, she was ushered into a medical process that changed her body forever.

Irreversible Pain and Damage

Clementine Breen's story is even more harrowing —and now, it's a legal fight. Breen, a 19-year-old college student, is suing Dr. Johanna Olson-Kennedy, one of the leading figures in "transgender medicine." At just 12 years old, Breen was put on puberty blockers and given testosterone, eventually undergoing a mastectomy at 14. Breen now suffers from a deep voice, an Adam's apple, brittle bones, and severe physical and emotional pain.

Breen is suing based on the failure of medical staff to treat her properly with medical safeguards and accurate treatment. Instead, she was pushed into irreversible treatments even though she could not possibly comprehend the consequences. In favor of promoting left-wing ideology, Dr. Olson-Kennedy ignored psychological concerns and basic medical standards in favor of a transition for adolescent Breen. Now Breen, like Mosley, is left with lifelong damage and regrets and hopes to shut down doctors like Dr. Olson-Kennedy.

Exploitation for Profit

Breen and Mosley are not alone. Their cases shine a spotlight on the medical system that has allowed children and teens to be pushed down a path of gender transition with little regard for their mental health or the irreversible consequences of such decisions. The rapidly growing number of similar lawsuits reflects the increasing dissatisfaction and anger of detransitioners who were exploited for profit by a system that prioritized transitioning over real care.

As Mosley put it, "As soon as a person says, 'I'm trans' or, 'I have gender dysphoria,' doctors start experimenting on them and lie to them and don't hold themselves to medical standards anymore... There was nothing wrong with my body that had to be treated with medicine."

For Mosley and Breen, the consequences are devastating: chronic pain, regret, and a sense of betrayal from a medical field they thought they could trust.

Fighting for Justice

As more individuals speak out about the dangers of gender-affirming treatments, the push for accountability grows. Lawsuits like Breen's are part of a broader legal reckoning, with detransitioners fighting for justice after undergoing irreversible procedures at the hands of doctors they trusted.

For the time being, America's children have received a reprieve from the insanity of the pressure to transition. Now is the time for the church to stand up and demand a permanent, irreversible ban on these life-altering procedures. By standing firm in biblical truth, we can help guide society toward a healthier, Bible-based conversation on gender and family roles, while protecting the most vulnerable, like Breen and Mosley, from irreversible harm.

God's Judgment Beginning to Get People's Attention

For a couple of generations, the Western World has enjoyed unparalleled prosperity. Now we are seeing it fading. With groceries up 30 percent, rent doubling, home ownership out of reach, and cars costing more than houses used to, people are asking what happened. Satan is ready with lots of answers —all based on lies.

But a few thought leaders are beginning to ask the right questions, rediscovering that prosperity comes from God's blessing when we do it God's way. On the other hand, disobedience breeds chaos.

Wesley Huff Points to a Spiritual Shift

One of the key voices in this revival is Wesley Huff, a Canadian academic and Christian apologist. On *The Joe Rogan Experience*, Huff argued that God is working "behind the scenes" to guide influential figures toward Christianity. From Ayaan Hirsi Ali to Joe Rogan himself, Huff sees a growing wave of public figures rediscovering faith in a

search for meaning and moral clarity.

Ayaan Hirsi Ali Boldly Converts

Ayaan Hirsi Ali was once a Muslim, a fierce critic of religion and an outspoken atheist. Then she stunned the world in 2024 by publicly embracing Christianity. Her decision highlights a growing trend of former skeptics turning to faith, drawn by the profound wisdom and moral strength of Christian doctrine.

When discussing what drew her to Christianity, she pointed to the intellectual freedom and morality inherent within the Christian faith. "To me, this freedom of conscience and speech is perhaps the greatest benefit of Western civilization...."

Russell Brand Transformed by Faith

Russell Brand, the former hedonist turned spiritual seeker, has undergone a striking transformation. Once known for his wild lifestyle and criticism of societal norms, Brand now speaks openly about his devotion to Jesus Christ. not even getting confirmation that its citizens are still alive.


The two-state solution—the same flawed plan that's been a source of conflict for decades—is also on the table as part of the ceasefire. The idea of creating a Palestinian state alongside Israel, while Israel's security is compromised, remains a point of contention. Critics rightly argue this is simply another way of undermining Israel's legitimacy and safety.

Israel, the victim, is being told to stand down. Hamas started the war with an unprovoked massacre that left 1,200 Israelis dead and 250 kidnapped. Despite this, the U.S. pushed for a ceasefire where Israel was asked to make major concessions, while Hamas—who initiated the violence—was not held to the same standard.

Disastrous California Wildfires

Just days before the **January 15**, **2025 ceasefire**, California went up in flames. **Catastrophic wildfires** swept through coastal cities, killing dozens, displacing thousands, and destroying entire communities. It's hard to ignore See **Consequences** page 6

deaths—choosing euthanasia in 2021 alone. And this number is expected to rise as euthanasia becomes a recommended solution for suffering, bypassing real care and support.

Euthanasia Preys on the Vulnerable

When life is no longer valued, the most vulnerable are preyed upon. Take the 2023 case of Kathrin Mentler, a 37-year-old woman from Vancouver. She went to the hospital seeking help for suicidal thoughts, hoping to receive support to stay alive. Instead, a clinician suggested she consider Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD). Mentler was horrified. She had reached out for help to live but was instead offered a way to die.

Sadly, this is not an isolated incident.

In December 2022, Canadian veteran Christine Gauthier received a shocking response from Veterans Affairs Canada (VAC). After years of delays in her request for a wheelchair lift to help her navigate her home—due to permanent injuries from a 1989 Canadian Army training accident—Gauthier was offered euthanasia as an alternative. After overcoming tremendous challenges and serving her country, Gauthier's fight for basic assistance was met with the chilling suggestion that she should end her life.

British Columbia professor Tim Stainton didn't mince words when he warned that Canada's euthanasia laws pose "probably the biggest existential threat to disabled people since the Nazis."

the **timing** of these events.

McTernan suggests that when America pressures Israel, divine retribution follows. Could these wildfires be a sign? A spiritual consequence for forcing Israel into an unjust agreement?

Amid claims that the California fires are being fueled by heat, drought, and mismanagement, what if the timing is more than just a coincidence? Could this be a response to **America's role** in putting pressure on Israel to compromise? The U.S.-Israel relationship is more than just political; it's **spiritually significant**. And the timing of these disasters raises serious questions.

Israel's Struggle to Stand

The ceasefire deal might be a dangerous misstep for Israel, one that

weakens its security and emboldens its enemies. While the U.S. continues to act as a mediator, it must stop forcing Israel to make **unnecessary sacrifices** in the name of peace. Releasing **terrorists** in exchange for **hostages** is not a fair trade. Telling **Israel to stand down** after Hamas' brutal attacks is a slap in the face to the lives lost and the families torn apart.

The world has seen the damage of the two-state solution—and the **ceasefire deal** perpetuates that flawed ideology. A Palestinian state at Israel's expense won't bring peace; it will only **further jeopardize Israel's safety**.

As Israel contemplates its next steps, let us pray for the peace of Israel and encourage our politicians to act on Israel's behalf. If these **wildfires** are any indication, the cost of this deal is not just political, but much, much greater.

Canadians Pressured into Suicide Over Cost

Canada's socialized healthcare system is supposed to ensure access to healthcare for all. In reality, the system creates financial incentives that encourage vulnerable individuals to consider euthanasia instead of true medical assistance.

One woman with cerebral palsy was told by a doctor in Newfoundland that she would be "selfish" if she didn't consider euthanasia because of the cost associated with her care. Another man with a degenerative brain disorder secretly recorded a hospital director of ethics suggesting he consider euthanasia because his ongoing care would cost "north of \$1,500 a day."

Human Life is Devalued

As Canada accelerates its embrace of

euthanasia, the West must take a hard look at the dangerous implications of this trend. The expansion of assisted suicide is not just a Canadian issue but a global shift that threatens the very sanctity of life. Euthanasia is a symptom of a society that has lost its moral compass. We must stand firm in upholding the biblical truth that every life has value—no matter the challenges of illness, disability, or mental health.

Now is the time to defend life, in all its forms. The West must reject the growing normalization of euthanasia and ensure that no life is seen as expendable. The church also has a role to play. We need to get the Gospel out and share God's view of His creation. This life is not all there is; our hope is in heaven. But unless people are presented with the gospel, they might end up believing the lie that ending their life is the only answer.

father experienced —and the Bible agrees. Relationships where people care for one another and support each other in joy and hardship are what the Bible prescribes for a healthy community where everyone thrives together.

Service Creates a Sense of Purpose

Murthy also emphasized the importance of service as essential to well-being. Service connects us to others and gives our lives meaning. Whether it's helping a neighbor, volunteering, or simply listening, acts of service offer something that wealth and status never can: a sense of purpose.

Jesus Himself set the example, demonstrating that he didn't come to be served but to serve. Murthy affirms that, when we serve others, we step outside of ourselves and contribute to the greater good. This creates a sense of fulfillment that does not come from personal achievement but from knowing that we've made a difference in someone else's life.

Service also strengthens our bonds with others, deepening our connections and fostering a community spirit. It's a simple, powerful way to combat the loneliness and disconnection that plagues so many today.

Prioritize Living for What Matters

Finally, Murthy highlighted the need for better priorities. In a society obsessed with fame, wealth, and power, he calls for a shift away from such fleeting pursuits. He encourages everyone to build a life that truly matters, filled with

"I am in the business of service. [I] serve Jesus Christ. And it's such a powerful idea that I'm held alive by it."

Jordan Peterson Marvels Over the Bible

Jordan Peterson, the Canadian psychologist and intellectual, has become another major voice in this Christian thought revival. Peterson's discussions on the Bible—particularly on *The Joe Rogan Experience*—have sparked widespread interest.

Peterson argues that the Bible offers deep moral and psychological insights essential for understanding human nature. He also highlights its relevance in today's world, stating that we cannot hope for a beneficial society without it.

Joe Rogan's Surprising Spiritual Journey

But there is one biblical concept that is not being talked much about —judgment. These people are not yet connecting God's direct promise that He would bring judgment. He promised to mess with the weather, spoil their crops, unleash wars and pandemics. When sin blossoms, everyone begins to hurt. God's only choice is to tighten down on man's freedom and standard of living.

When God called Jack Chick to the publication ministry, Jack saw the need for emphasizing God's judgment. An era of easy-believism was emerging in the church and needed the counterbalance of literature pointing out the results of a lukewarm Christianity. A great danger

church.

They have used all their tracts, and are waiting anxiously for more ammunition – a shipment of 400,000 Chick tracts! As of the time of this writing, we still need funding for this project.

Philippines

Even though we have sent several containers of Chick tracts here, that's just a drop in the bucket for this country of 120 million people. Whether out of curiosity or envy, the Chick tract became a jump starter for a conversation that opened the door for France to hear the gospel, by which he confessed Jesus Christ as his personal Lord and Saviour!"

It works!

Honduras

Two things are happening here. First, Missionary Scott Sumner and his congregation are still pushing out the 200,000 Chick tracts they received. Sumner has a welcome from the military and police academies to preach to their cadets and give them Chick tracts. In the picture on the next page, we see just one of the military groups that he has been invited to preach to. They are holding the Bibles and Chick tracts that

he gave them.

They also faithfully work the streets with Chick tracts.

In addition to Sumner's work, another 200,000 Chick tracts were included in a container that went to Honduras. Below are local pastors loading their truck with tracts to blanket their city.

Next Opportunities

Here are more things going on at the time of this writing:

- 50,000 tracts going to Greece, where a young missionary couple travels the country with a group of young people, preaching in the markets and distributing Chick tracts.
- One million Chick tracts are headed for Guatemala. Missionary Carlos Donate says the tracts "literally fly off the shelves" at his ministry storehouse, as pastors come in to stock up for street witnessing.

- 165,000 tracts, in Pidgin and English, are being prepared for Missionary Ken Seremak to use in helping to establish new churches in the Western Highlands of Papua New Guinea.
- 10,000 French "This Was Your Life" will be printed for Missionary James Herringson on the island of Mauritius, in the Indian Ocean east of Madagascar. They have been using these tracts for

outreach since 2023 and report that they are seeing souls saved! They need more.

- Veteran missionary Noel Shrivnauth has 20,000 Chick tracts on the way for his continued soul-winning in Guyana, along the northeast coast of South America.
- We still need funding to help send the container of nearly 2 million Chick tracts to the Philippines. The list of ministries receiving them rotates from container to container. Those who have requested these have run out and need more! They are willing to do the footwork to reach their nation. Let's give them the tools.

Gone are the days when religious leaders can say, "Gospel tracts do not work." The people being saved in missions work around the world show that this is not so. But tracts don't give themselves out!


