Former Prime Minister Suggests One World Leader

The coronavirus pandemic is landing at the intersection between a push for a one-world government and the struggle for freedom. The U.S. president is adamant that America will continue our effort to maintain the constitutional rule of law that guarantees our freedoms of religion, speech and assembly.

But a former British Prime Minister, Gordon Brown, recently voiced his support for the need of a single world-wide authority to orchestrate the defense against the disease. He called for it to be “temporary” just for this one event, but such efforts rarely back off without a fight to take down such a power grab.

Another sign of the times is a hand stamp that the officials in India are printing on the back of the hands of those who are flying into the country from states where the coronavirus is growing. The Indian Minister of Health bragged: “If anyone tries to evade or break quarantine they can now be caught.” As believers this is a reminder of the prophecy that such a mark would be required when the one-world

Just as their “Jesus” is still hanging on the crucifix waiting to be dispensed as a wafer-god in communion by a priest, forgiveness comes not from our risen Advocate, Jesus, but from an “ordained” member of the power structure.

So, what is wrong with this picture?

If you believe the Bible to be God’s final word on the subject, nowhere does He give man permission to forgive sins (absolution). Catholic teaching relies on John 20:23 for their authority to absolve other people of their sins. Nowhere in the New Testament do we see the apostles acting on this interpretation. Nowhere in the Bible does it instruct or even permit man to go to another man for forgiveness from God. Jesus is the only advocate that we are given (1 John 2:1) and the only mediator (1 Timothy 2:5).

It is of note that the NIV and ESV take the Catholic interpretation of this verse, giving the apostles full authority to forgive sins.

As the threat of the pandemic progressed, Pope Francis attempted several ploys. He went to two shrines near the Vatican to pray to the Virgin Mary goddess. This illustrated Catholicism’s elbowing Jesus aside and replacing Him with a goddessified perversion of the humble mother of our Lord. Again, ignored is 1 Timothy 2:5 that Jesus is the only mediator.

Then the pope conceded that the people could go directly to God for forgiveness, but only with proper “contrition” and immediately return to confession and Mass as soon as possible. In effect, this was nullified by a pronouncement that he would personally grant a “plenary indulgence,” supposedly canceling all guilt for everybody who practiced proper “contrition.”

Some would argue that “contrition” is equal to “repentance,” but the lives of so many Roman Catholics demonstrate otherwise. They appear at the veiled window of confession to say: “I’m sorry,” receive a bogus forgiveness from the priest, and continue on, ignoring God’s true redemption.

An additional event illustrated another of the pope’s violations of scripture: a rare display of the Shroud of Turin. This is a 14-foot-long length of cloth that supposedly wrapped Jesus in the tomb. Catholics get as close to relics like this as they can, hoping it will give them a blessing or a miracle in return.

ruler, the anti-Christ, gains control.



How Do You Know They Are Real?

One of the latest tourist attractions in Washington, DC is the Museum of the Bible. It was initially funded by David Green, founder of the chain of arts and craft stores, Hobby Lobby. For DC visitors interested in the history of the Bible, it is a must visit.

One of the displays contains fragments of what was labeled the Dead Sea Scrolls. In 1947, some shepherds discovered ancient jars of documents in remote caves in Israel. Bible historians have had a treasure trove for their research. While they ultimately did not reveal anything revolutionary about Bible history, they made quite a splash on

the academic scene.

Of course, the Museum of the Bible is the ideal place to display samples of the Dead Sea Scrolls. A few years ago Green purchased 16 fragments believing that they were from the Dead Sea Scrolls. He is personally a collector of ancient documents and the museum was in the planning stages.

Before completion of the museum, some scholars began to question the history (provenance) of the fragments. When the museum was finished, Green displayed them but with a notice that there was some question about them. A small sample was



That among the most precious items of cargo on the Mayflower on her first trip to America were pastor John Robinson's tracts?

That a son of one of the chiefs of Burdwan, India, was converted by a single tract and that he was instrumental in winning 1,500 natives to Christ?

A pastor in England asked a dying Christian woman where she found the Saviour. She gave him a piece of paper torn from an American Journal containing one of C.H. Spurgeon's sermons. The scrap had been wrapped around a package that came to her from Australia. The words of Spurgeon were read by her and were the means of leading her to Christ.

Commenting on this incident, a writer says, "Think of it, a sermon preached in England, printed in America, in some way coming to Australia, has a part of it used in wrapping paper there, coming back to England, was the means of converting this woman."

What an encouragement there is in such an incident for those who preach the gospel by means of printer's ink! Tracts and religious papers have been wonderfully used of God in the salvation of souls. *

submitted for evaluation and the report indicated that they were "inconsistent with ancient origins."

Rather than quietly withdrawing them from display, the Museum sponsored scientific testing of the entire collection of the fragments. After several months of thorough elemental and molecular analysis it was concluded that they were a very clever fabrication done sometime in the 20th century.

To many of us, these obscure workings of museums may seem disconnected from the real world where we live. However, the authenticity of "ancient" documents can have enormous consequences.

An example is the two Bible manuscripts that underpin almost the entire selection of

modern Bibles: the Codex Sinaiticus and the Codex Vaticanus. Belief that they are truly the earliest copies that we have of the Bible has led scholars to alter the reading of most of the Bibles used by pastors and Bible teachers today.

The report produced by the researchers into the fragments in the Museum of the Bible spoke several times about their “provenance.” This term is used for the history of the document. If a document appears out of nowhere, that is considered an immediate cause for suspicion.

It is important to be able to trace the “chain of custody,” where it was first discovered, who owned it and who else was it transferred to in its history. These were the primary factors in times past, but today modern science has handed us another tool to examine them down to the molecules of the parchment and ink of the documents.

The final report available on the Museum of the Bible website is over 200 pages long and makes fascinating reading.

Author and Linguist David W. Daniels has used modern research techniques to raise questions about the authenticity of the Sinaiticus and Vaticanus Codices. He does

not have the resources to do in-depth scientific analysis but has done extensive research into their record of the provenance and chain of custody.

What he has found is very disturbing for anyone who is relying on the modern Bible versions. The Vaticanus has no history prior to 1475 and the Sinaiticus before 1840. Daniels has also discovered that museums who hold the original Vaticanus and Sinaiticus documents have refused to allow them to be scientifically evaluated.

Also, the contents of both of them vary widely from the 5700+ manuscripts in the stream of reliable Biblical history supporting the King James Bible. Many verses, chapters, and whole books are missing. (Vaticanus does not contain the book of Revelation.)

Harvard Hosts Anti-Homeschool Summit

Because of the coronavirus, many parents have experienced homeschooling for the first time. Most are not aware of the controversy surrounding this practice. But those who have chosen homeschooling instead of the public school's propaganda mill are very aware of the risk they're taking.

The Home School Legal Defense Association (HSLDA) has been the main line of defense protecting the fragile rights of parents to have the final say on what is taught to their children. HSLDA willingly steps into any fray between homeschooling parents and intrusive bureaucrats, usually with significant success.

A "summit" called this summer at Harvard University demonstrates the prestige of the forces arrayed against parents who dare exercise their right to homeschooling. The title of the meeting is: "The Homeschooling Summit: Problems, Politics, and the Prospects for Reform." Its stated purpose is to bring together leaders in education and child welfare policy to discuss child rights and homeschooling.

You would think that the organizers of this summit in this "ivy league atmosphere of unbiased research" would want to hear all sides of the issue. However, not only was HSLDA not invited, members of the panel have previously expressed strong bias against this homeschool legal defender and homeschooling in general.

One panel member, Samantha Field, wrote in an article: "The Home School Legal Defense Association has fomented a culture of suspicion and wild conspiracy theories that may put children in danger."

Another panelist, Dr. Rachel Coleman, is founder of the Coalition for Responsible Home Education and holds the view that homeschooling must be more firmly regulated by the government.

The writings of other panelists demonstrate a broad hostility to homeschooling in general. One suggested that a child should be permitted to go to court to force his parents to allow him to attend public school. Another suggested: "The reason parent-child relationships exist is because the State confers legal Parenthood."

Another suggested an outside person should be required to look into the situation and see whether the child is "meeting educational outcomes."

Homeschooling is just another aspect of the global debate over parental rights versus child's rights. In 1989, the United Nations adopted the Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC). It included the rights to:

- Life, survival and development
- Protection from violence, abuse or neglect
- An education that enables them to fulfil their potential
- To be raised by, or have a relationship with their parents
- Express their opinions and be listened to.

There are a number of these UN conventions that are like treaties. The United Nations formulates these treaties on various subjects such as violence, terrorism, human rights, etc. Countries that agree to abide by the guidelines of these conventions sign on. One hundred ninety-six countries have signed on UNCRC with only one remaining —the United States.

Our US constitution specifies that such treaties are highly binding and US leaders have been reluctant to hand that kind of power to the globalist UN. This is fortunate, because it would be much more difficult for parents here to homeschool their children without intrusion by the state.

The risk is illustrated by the widely differing views of education. In public schools, the state has illustrated its abhorrence of Biblical teaching, promoting instead such sinful practices as sexual perversion and humanistic evolution. Should the state ever gain control of the curriculum for homeschoolers, the content would no doubt be significantly modified.

The current nationwide closure of the public schools will, no doubt, show many parents that there is an alternative to the indoctrination in the government schools.

One of them, Bruce Hunsaker, is sent out of Blessed Hope Baptist Church in New York. Like many missionaries, he did not answer God's call through one of the well-known mission boards, but went with the backing only of his home church, who knew his calling and ministry. In this recent letter, he shares the emotional reality of what you have made possible there:

“Thank you, the partnership the Lord arranged for us in the beginning hit us with shock. No Bible school, no years of deputation. I did not know how well I would do in a foreign country in my 50’s. Pastor Brian Kelly began several years ago with a simple table of Chick Tracts set up in a subway of New York City. There he learned that people do read Chick Tracts and, since New York is the crossroads of the world, they preferred them in their native languages. Mix that with a lifelong passion for getting the gospel to those on their way to hell, Kelly was in a perfect spot. After handing out hundreds of thousands of tracts for several years to subway riders, a new opportunity opened up and he moved his display to the corner of 51st and Broadway in Manhattan and added more tables.



Every Sunday for the last seven years, numerous tables on that corner have displayed almost every major language of Chick tracts. After working with Chick tracts for so long, he knows the stories by heart and the focus of each tract.

If in conversation he learns that they are Muslim and speak Arabic, he will give them [*Greatest Story Ever Told*](#) in their language. If they are Mormon, he gives [*The Visitors*](#), maybe even in their native tongue.

He says that he usually gets an expression of delight as they see their own language, plus the quality of the colorful booklet makes it hard to turn down. Once they open it and see the cartoons, they are hooked.

But Kelly's reward and joy is when someone comes back to report a change of life. This happens often because Kelly is faithful to always be at the same place every Sunday and they know where to find him. Of course, this requires a complete set-up and tear-down every Sunday. He uses folding tables and lots of 21-pocket wire tract display racks obtainable from Chick Publications.

He also sets up a few folding chairs in front of a small podium where he conducts regular church for a dozen or so who wish to attend. It also provides a worship center for his half dozen helpers and his wife.

When people do come back for more, Kelly credits the ongoing power of the many



scriptures in the tracts that goes beyond just initial salvation. He will then recommend an assortment of Bible tracts including [This Was Your Life](#), [Empty Tomb](#) or [Love Story](#). He also displays other discipleship and spiritual training literature for the taking. If he has time, he or his wife will provide some spiritual counseling on the side.

Kelly's display is so broad that he usually has a tract on whatever topic he thinks the person would be interested in. If he detects homosexuality, he will offer whatever tracts that he has available such as [Doom Town](#), [Sin City](#), [Home Alone](#), and [Uninvited](#). If they are Roman Catholic, he prefers [Are Roman Catholics Christians?](#) and [Why Is Mary Crying?](#) He will also use the appropriate tract or tracts for Mormons or Jehovah's Witnesses.

Because he is able to hand out over 50,000 tracts a month, some of the donors to his ministry have purchased an entire 10,000-copy press run of out-of-stock titles such as [Uninvited](#) and [Is There Another Christ?](#) Kelly's humble, obvious concern for the spiritual destiny of the people who pass him every day, blunts some of the washback that will always come with such a bold witness.

Kelly says that New York City is a pressure place and most people passing by appear stressed. But he likes to watch when someone opens a Chick tract for the first time. He says that the story immediately engages their interest, but the scripture is what does the job. He says he sees their countenance sometimes soften as they continue reading.

He and his wife and team have a special compassion for the homeless. They will make peanut butter and jelly sandwiches to go along with the tracts. In fact, sometimes someone will try to refuse the tracts until they see the sandwiches.

Some who visit his display share the same passion to get the gospel out and will take a handful to pass on and then return for more.
