

Pope Makes Social Call to Iraq

With the COVID lockdowns receding, Pope Francis is back to building bridges. This time, it is with the Shiite Muslims. Early in March, Grand Ayatollah Ali al-Sistani welcomed the pope at his residence in Najaf, Iraq. Other stops included Baghdad's presidential palace and a Catholic cathedral where terrorists massacred 48 people in 2010.

There was high symbolism in another event held at the ancient archaeological site of Ur. According to Genesis 11, Ur was Abraham's hometown, whence he was called out by God to travel to Canaan. And since Islam, Judaism and Christianity all claim Abraham as a common spiritual father, this visit sent a strong message of unity.

Supreme Court Establishes Strong Precedent for Soul Winners

A U.S. Supreme Court decision has solidly backed the rights of soul winners to share their faith on college campuses. In 2016, two students at Gwinnett College in Georgia were sharing their faith with other students on campus. Campus police accosted them and said that they would have to get a permit to share their faith in a

special zone set aside for that purpose on campus. Students Chike Uzuegbunam and Joseph Branford duly applied for a permit to use the two tiny speech zones that the college had set aside. When they tried to use that permit, they were stopped by police because a fellow student had expressed discomfort with their message.

The violation of their rights was so blatant that a major Christian legal association, Alliance Defending Freedom, took up the case. After several years of contradictory findings by the

Another girder in the pope's bridge is the fact that both Islam and Catholicism claim to revere Jesus —Islam as a prophet and the pope as a wafer god.

Iraq is the 10th Muslim country that Pope Francis has visited in his tenure, and he has hosted several Vatican events with Muslim leaders.

There were gracious speeches all around: "It is essential to ensure the participation of all political, social and religious groups and to guarantee the fundamental rights of all citizens. May no one be considered a second-class citizen," the pope admonished.

president Barham Iraqi Salid's response: "Your insistence on visiting Iraq despite the difficulties of the pandemic, and the hard times witnessed by our country, doubles the value of the visit to Iragis."

Both are well aware of the gulf between them. Before the U.S. invasion of Iraq, there were an estimated 1.4 million people who claimed allegiance to Christianity. Today, fewer than 250,000 remain. The country is now 98.5% Muslim

Discrimination is intense. Muslim women are forbidden to marry non-Muslims. Conversion is prohibited to any other religion from Islam. Children must be registered as Muslim if they are from a mixed marriage.

How sad this charade is. The political head of a counterfeit "church" boldly claims to come in the Holy Name of our Lord to advance the worship of a wafer god and virgin goddess.

Fortunately, there are reports of underground believers in some of the Muslim countries. One missionary reported that the church in Iran was one of the fastest growing in the world, though Islam's brutality drives them to silence, so it is hard to get real numbers.

Persistent soul winners have been looking for holes in their iron curtain where the gospel could be filtered in through the internet and TV and radio channels.

There is also some hope from the commercial and political side. Several of the countries have recently established diplomatic and business relationships with Israel. This is a real turnabout, and hopefully it will allow Bible-believing missionaries into some of these formerly very closed and dangerous countries.

Our hearts should break when we realize that the pope and the ayatollahs represent over 2 billion people who are lost in idolatry and pagan deception. One

Newfound Dead Sea Scrolls Prove Bible History

God chose to preserve His words for us in the context of provable history. No other world religion has this kind of book. And the spade of the archaeologist continues to dig up proof that it is true.

After Israel became an independent nation over 50 years ago, archaeology was freed to examine the land. But it was a group of shepherds who made the greatest find. Amusing themselves by throwing rocks at openings in the cliffs


in the Judean desert, they heard the sound of breaking pottery. There, in a cave, they found sealed jars that proved to contain preserved documents dating back 2000 vears.

Written on the documents were almost exact copies of portions of our present Bible. These became known as the Dead Sea Scrolls, or Qumran Scrolls.

The Israeli government has since established an Antiquities Authority

lower courts, the US Supreme Court agreed to hear the case.

Over two dozen other legal advocacy organizations filed friend-of-the-court briefs with the Supreme Court. That's because this case was pivotal in dealing with an obscure legal maneuver.

To avoid court action in the past, colleges had simply changed their rules before the case went to court and the judge would then dismiss the case as if there was no violation of freedom of speech. But that ruling did not place a barrier against the school reinstituting the restrictions.

In this case, however, attorneys had changed their appeal in a way that the court had to rule on it for all future instances. This is why the case got so much attention and, with an 8-1 ruling in favor of free speech, turned out to be a major victory for the future.

The victory was even greater because it applies not only to colleges and universities but to any other government or private organization that attempts to limit soul winning in a public area.

Many in the new generation are persuaded that such public witnessing is ineffective; that relational evangelism is the only way to go. However, those who have been trained in tract distribution know that it is a way that works.

A flood of testimonies have come to our office over the years. Some have testified of suicides prevented. Others simply told of the memory of a picture in the tract that left them with a nagging awareness of God. Finally, the Holy spirit used it to persuade them to follow Jesus.

This ruling should be an encouragement to soul winners. We must stand boldly against the darkness of a culture going barbaric. Abortion, infanticide, euthanasia, power to the few, unjust incarceration, worship of false gods or lying ideologies, sex trafficking, etc., have been the norm in cultures without the influence of Christ.

America has enjoyed unprecedented freedom from these sins for a few hundred years because enough people were committed to Biblical principles, and when sin began to grow, righteous people would stand publicly against it.

One of the ways they spread the truth of Christ's power to heal hearts —and the culture— was with gospel tracts. The Great Awakenings (revivals) in America and the Western World were often preceded with saturation with gospel tracts.

With most of the modern media opposed to the gospel, tracts are still an effective way to spread truth. And we need freedom to do that. But the freedom is worthless without the boldness to actually do it.

to handle all of the archaeological discoveries. And there have been many.

Recently, more scroll fragments were found in a cave that was reachable only with climbing gear. As expected, they contained verses from the Old Testament; specifically, the books of Nahum (ch. 1, v. 5-6) and Zachariah (ch. 8:16-17.)

One Israeli official observed: "These finds are not just important to our own cultural heritage, but to that of the entire world." This statement is especially true given the power of the gospel of God's word to change the course of civilization.

Another recent discovery, in 1993, was a stone fragment inscribed with the description of a battle. An Aramean king is boasting of a victory over several thousand Israelite and Judahite horsemen and charioteers. He claims to have killed two kings, a "king of Israel" and the "king of the House of David." The inscription, called the Tel Dan stela, is not complete on the stone fragment and does not name the kings. But scholars believe that it refers to a defeat of Jehoram and Ahaziah.

The website, *biblicalarchaeology.org*, has many more accounts of archaeological discoveries that continue to validate the Biblical record. No discovery has ever been found to directly contradict the Biblical account.

With the abundance of search engines and other research tools, many skeptics are setting out to discredit the Bible. But when they are honest enough to follow the evidence, many are converted and have recently written numerous books about what they found.

All this should strengthen our boldness and zeal to counter with Truth the wave of lies engulfing our world.

A Pandemic Bigger Than COVID-19

"Anxiety disorders are the most common mental illness in the U.S., affecting 40 million adults in the United States age 18 and older, or 18.1% of the population every year," according to the Anxiety & Depression Association of America (adaa.org). And these are the ones severe enough to achieve a diagnosis. And notice that it doesn't include children.

We did a full attack against the coronavirus in just a year. This mental illness epidemic is an ongoing and escalating problem, year after year. U.S. suicide rate increased 24% between 1999 and 2014, totaling over 48,000 in 2018.

Modern medical technology has done

a great job creating new names for old problems. Fear (aka anxiety) has been common to man since the Eden exit. Man's first fear caused him to hide after he disobeyed God's simple plan for peace and happiness in Eden (Genesis 3:10).

And that pattern has not changed. When we ignore God's loving plan for our peace, it becomes a scary world. America has abandoned that plan and is trying to substitute government policies for God's word. That has never worked out well in any country that has tried it.

Jack Chick understood this when he wrote *Fatal Decision*. The patient in the story thought he was fine and scorned the

Jo Anna Woody heads a prison ministry, Mission Possible, that has partnered with Chick Publications for several decades. She and her late husband, Alan, pioneered the outreach that supplies literature to chaplains in several states. Their emphasis has been on providing Bibles and literature. She reports: "This past year, 108,946 souls have received 2,500 Bibles, 101,360 tracts, 4,021 comic books, and 1,030 books to help them in their Christian walk!"

One chaplain reported that an assortment of Crusader Comics was distributed in the jail. Later, he looked out at the exercise yard where there was normally a lot of arguing and sometimes fights among the inmates. Instead, the men were sitting quietly reading, and trading the comics. The quiet caught the warden's attention and the chaplain invited him to take a look.

Another chaplain worked in a reception center with a lot of turnover. He reported that 6200 men came through in the last year and each one got a gospel tract. 590 of them had professed new faith in Christ and nearly 700 had made a rededication. He had

heard from 51 others who shared their faith with someone else who also came to Christ. One inmate, who knew sign language, led a deaf man to Christ.

Jo Anna reports: "The demand for Bibles has been way down because of the pandemic, but the demand for the comics is way up. Every request received in December was met —and that includes those powerful comics. I get them at a good discount, but they are still costly. The chaplains ask hesitantly for them because of that. One dear chaplain in Mississippi called me three times thanking us for the four hundred we sent him. They deeply appreciate your support in getting these valuable books with such powerful messages! Thank you for giving so generously to make eternal differences in lives."

God Not Welcome in Congress?

"...what any religious tradition describes as God's will is no concern of this Congress." Could it really be possible that this statement was recently made in a solemn session of the U.S. House of Representatives? The setting: a deliberation on the Equality Act that proposes to elevate homosexual behavior to a special protected status under the anti-discrimination code. Another congressman had just read Deuteronomy 22:5 (forbids crossdressing) into the record to illustrate the Biblical view of transgender deviancy.

The congressman reading the Deuteronomy verse was specifically targeting the transgender (gender identity) aspect of homosexuality. The greatest concern about the Equality Act is in this area. Making it illegal to discriminate against people who claim they are in the wrong body will disrupt many areas of civil society.

One of those areas that has been getting considerable attention lately is in women's sports. Men who decide they are women in a man's body are winning sports awards in contests against women athletes. The state of Connecticut has approved this foolishness and males have stolen trophies in at least 15 events from the female athletes. Then the girls even have to dodge these men in the dressing rooms and restrooms.

Another disturbing aspect of transgenderism teaches children that before they reach puberty they may possibly be in the wrong body. If so, then "we can sneak you off for puberty blockers and later, surgery to make you into the true you. Never mind that it will probably totally destroy your general health and prevent you from ever having any babies."

But anyone who tries to talk you out of it may end up in jail for performing illegal "conversion therapy."

Speaking of jail, this Equality Act specifically nullifies the 1993 Religious Freedom Restoration Act that protects churches, Christian owned businesses, and

parachurch organizations against lawsuits, fines and imprisonment for refusing transgenders from joining.

Church leaders are alarmed by a provision forbidding discrimination for gender identity in "any stadium or place of establishment that provides exhibition, entertainment, recreation, exercise, amusement, gathering, or display." Churches that have changed from "worship services" to worship "gatherings" should note this terminology.

For several years some Christianoperated businesses have been under attack, such as cake bakers and florists, who refused service to weddings and ceremonies that they deemed sinful. These are covered by a provision in the act forbidding discrimination by "any establishment that provides a good, service, or program, including a store, shopping center, online retailer, or service provider, etc."

A possible scenario might include a lawsuit against a food service who refuses to cater a transition party for a transgender who then approaches a church for a same-sex marriage ceremony and threatens legal action if they refuse.

When we think of this as absurd, we need to remember that 20 years ago we would not have believed a scantily dressed drag queen would be reading children's books to kiddies in the local library.

As Jesus warned in Luke 17 that, as it was in "the days of Noah" or in "the days of Lot," the debauchery would become so widespread that sudden destruction was the only solution. God demonstrated to Jonah His concern for the children in Nineveh (Jonah 4:11). Will He not be equally concerned when we prescribe puberty blockers for 12-year-olds and genital mutilation at 18?

Soul winners, it appears like we are nearing sundown. We have work to do. Churches have slept too long. History shows that tract saturation is a low-cost way to wake up a community.





truth. He believed a lie and threw away the expensive gift of life bought with the ultimate sacrifice.

America today is sick and doesn't realize it. Riding merrily along on God's mercy, she does not see the social cancer eating at her vitals.

Jesus said we would see evil "as in the days of Noah (Luke 17:26-30). God told Noah: "My Spirit shall not always strive with man." We do not know where God draws the red line. But if we compare today with then, we cannot be far from it.

A few years ago, one church leader said that the believers must begin to take a prophetic stance like Jeremiah and Elijah. They were bold in their warnings, but sometimes frustrated when God extended His mercy longer than they thought that He should.

But we are not good stewards if we do not make full use of this period of mercy. While we have the freedom to share the good news and speak against the evil, we must not shirk our commission.
